
Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Breaking Out of the Box" using Luke 4:14-29. After fasting and praying for forty days, Jesus returned from the wilderness in the power of the Spirit. He came to Nazareth, his hometown, and they received Him not. They said, "Is not this Joseph's son?" They could not believe he was the Messiah, because they could not accept a child they saw grow up as God in flesh. They could not think outside the box. Sometimes we have to "preach outside the box." We must teach the truth. Traditions can be built on either truth or error. If they're based on error, we should let go of them. Our godly heritage is more than just a building. It is preaching the truth of holiness, salvation, and godliness. We are going to meet all kinds of people with different backgrounds and cultures, so we are going to have to be renewed in the spirit of our minds to meet the needs of each one of them. Believe God. In Luke 5:18-20, four friends brought a man with palsy to Jesus to be healed. They couldn't get to Jesus because of the multitude. These men went outside of the box in their thinking and lowered the man down to Jesus through the roof. The man was healed. Believe God. Look not on the circumstances; think outside of the box.
