## Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Knowing The Voice of God" using Habakkuk 2:1-2. In all your getting, get wisdom. This is wisdom: Whatever situation you face, find out God's will on the matter and do it. Study God's written Word, and then also seek His spoken Word. His spoken voice will not give you permission to sin and go against His written Word. Knowing God's voice is the most crucial matter in our walk with God. Here are four keys for how to hear and know God's voice: **Key #1 – God's voice in your heart often sounds like a flow of spontaneous thoughts, visions, feelings, or impressions.** It is seldom audible words, except when coming through other believers. (If you want to hear God in an audible voice, have enough respect to let brothers and sisters be used in prophecy). **Key #2 – Become still so you can sense God's flow of thoughts within.** When you are rested, calm, free from sin, and open to God, you will be free to see visions or have dreams that come from God. **Key #3 – As you pray, fix the eyes of your heart upon Jesus, seeing in the Spirit the dreams and visions of Almighty God.** **Key #4 – Journaling, the writing out of your prayers and God's answers, brings great freedom in hearing God's voice.** Write out your needs or questions, and then write down the answers from God. This is called two-way journaling. Later on you can test your writing against God's Word. Prayer is a two way street: we talk to God and then God talks and we listen. Sometimes an answer may be beyond words that can be heard with our ears. Some things can only be heard from the heart. Because people can get confused about which voice they are hearing, we all need the three-fold cord: (1) God's written Word, (2) God's spoken Word, and (3) the advice of godly leaders.

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "One Accord" using Acts 4:7-32 & 5:12. God gave the devil permission to take Job's children and his livestock, but not to kill Job. Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints. If you physically die while serving God, it is a great thing. To backslide is the only horrible death. We need this commitment: No matter who around me fails, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Some people come to church yet live a lie. They profess to know God, yet live sinfully. Judgment came quickly for Ananias and Sapphira. There is a Judgment Day coming for every man, woman and child. We need to walk worthy of the vocation wherewith we are called. After you've been baptized in Jesus name and received the Holy Ghost, don't slander the name of Jesus. Do not let sin become your identity. To those who do: Speak the truth in love. "The wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God" (James 1:20). The enemy has attacked, but we are still here. Why? We are in one accord, we are praying, we are attending church, we are living holy. God is on our side!

## Wednesday

CAC members gathered for our Annual Business Meeting. We started the meeting with prayer, and the Lord blessed us greatly in guiding us to conduct the business of the church. The most exciting and most important announcements to come from the

business meeting are that: (1) CAC has received a firm offer from a local church that is interested in buying our existing building for \$260,000, which if accepted and our conditions are met, and if it goes through at the bank, would position us to be able to build our new building on the new property. The vote was unanimous to accept the offer & set conditions. (2) CAC also voted unanimously to apply at the bank for a construction loan for our new building. This is very exciting news! Please continue in prayer! Thank you for being faithful!

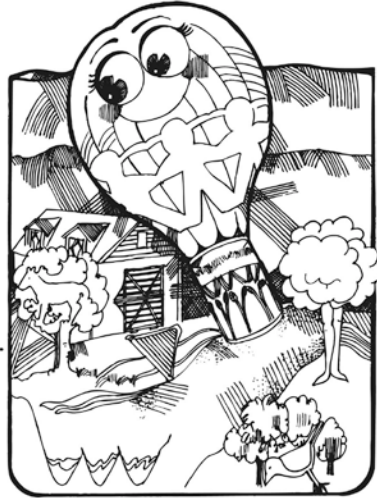
Last week's answer: Solomon offered burnt and peace offerings three times a year unto the Lord (found in 1 Kings 9: 25).

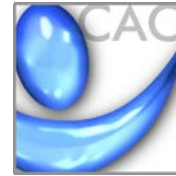

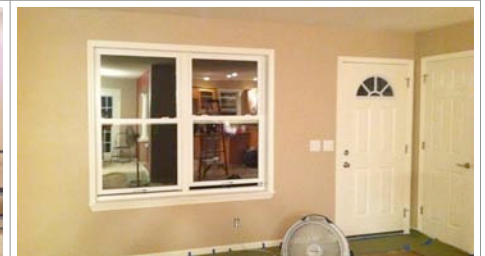
