Elder Keith Fought preached "Repairing Broken Altars" using I Kings 18:22-32. In the Scriptures, the number 12 speaks of governmental perfection or rule. There were: 12 disciples, 12 tribes of Israel, the wall of New Jerusalem has 12 foundations and the length, breadth and height of the city are 12,000 furlongs. The Word of God shows that Elijah took twelve stones to rebuild the altar. He did this to show that all the tribes of Israel should be joined in the worship of the Lord. The fire will fall in our churches and on our altar when we have every stone in place. The following are essential if we want the Holy Ghost to fall on us and consume us. (1) Desire – We must desire the Lord first in our lives. (2) Joy – The joy of the Lord is our strength. (3) Love – We must love God with all of our heart, mind and soul. (4) Commitment (5) Burden – We must have a burden to see souls saved. (6) Revelation – We must have a revelation of who Jesus is. (7) Submission – Keep close to God, submitting to His will. (8) Obedience (9) Holiness (10) Attitude – We must have a clean heart and right spirit within us. (11) Faith (12) Unity. Each of these 12 stones need to be in place for a closer walk with God.


