Pastor Joseph preached, "Worthy is the Lamb!" using Revelation 4:1-2,11 & ch. 5 as his texts. The creatures of heaven shout unto the Lord Jesus, "Thou art worthy!" John "the Revelator" was shown a scene in heaven in which a book (scroll) with seven seals was left unopened because no man in heaven, earth, nor under the earth, was worthy to open the book. John wept until one of the elders said, "Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof." Jesus is not only worthy to open that scroll in heaven, He is also worthy to be the Lord of your life. There is a consistent rule in this sin-cursed world: sin complicates things! The more sin is involved, the more complex any situation will be. When your situation is so complex that neither you nor anyone you know can guide you through, Jesus is worthy to guide you. Turn to Him! Seek Him! The path He steers you toward may involve some unavoidable discomfort and pain, but it is always the wisest choice to obey His leading in all things! Worthy is the Lamb!


Pastor Joseph preached, "Let's Have Revival" from Galatians 3:1 & Acts 4:29-31. Using our personal influence to sway people toward righteousness is wholesome, godly, and expected. However, for anyone to use their influence to sway people toward division, discord, or false doctrine, is a wrongful manipulation that the Apostle Paul likened to a basic form of witchcraft (see Galatians 3:1). Isaiah warned, "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!" (Isaiah 5:20). Some people harshly criticize the church for simply doing its job. Some try to manipulate the church. The devil's goal is to distract us from revival, to use up our time debating with those who refuse to be helped. What should our reply be? Focus on prayer, seeking God for boldness to speak his word, and praying for the Lord to confirm His word with signs and wonders. Ignore the insults, intimidation, threats and manipulation. Rather than let the enemy distract us at harvest time, let's focus on reaching the lost, and have revival!

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached "Make Straight the Way of the Lord" from John 1:23. In the earliest moments of creation, the earth did not have significant mountains and valleys. As a result, the earth was covered with water. The Lord then caused major mountains to serve as the continents and major valleys to serve as the ocean floors. He also made lesser mountains & valleys in many places. They are beautiful tributes to God's power, and some are needful for a proper ecology. However, some hinder mankind from making full use of the land. So at times, mountains must be brought down and valleys must be filled up. The carnal nature of mankind (the sin-cursed nature) is like a mountain that stands between people and where they need to be in God. The resultant lack of God's Spirit represents a terrible valley that must be brought up, by us being filled with God's Spirit and manifesting the fruit of the Spirit. The Lord Jesus taught that if we have faith as a grain of mustard seed, we can say unto a mountain, "Be thou removed and cast into the sea," and it will be done. These mountains and valleys can be made into a straight way, if we avail ourselves of God's power and grace.
