Elder Lorren Godwin preached from Matthew 23:25 that "Our Message is More Than Our Words." Our words tell a story, but our actions define our words. Many people *talk* of being a Christian, but their lifestyle does not back it up. We must be careful that we speak and live godly. This is one reason why so many people doubt whether the born-again experience is genuine. It takes only a few minutes of speaking with someone to discern what their true passion is. Whatever they are passionate about-hunting, sports, etc.-will eventually be revealed by their words. That is why a therapist often has a new patient to answer random questions (to start with); they are looking for words and thought patterns that reveal one's identity. Our words should be consumed with love and should reflect Jesus Christ, Still, on the surface it is so easy to say one thing, yet be and live something else. In Matthew 23:25 Jesus cautioned the people that it takes more than just cleaning the outside of the cup to make the cup clean. Noah was commanded to pitch the ark both inside and outside with pitch. It is imperative that our outward man *and* our inward man be changed in order to reflect Jesus Christ to the world. That is also why we must be careful of what we feed our mind. We will become what we watch, read, listen to, and who we hang out with. Just as our bodies are influenced by what we eat and drink, our minds are shaped by what we see and hear. We must guard our minds and prohibit certain ideas and thoughts from residing. To be a Christian is neither just a religion nor just saying the right things. It involves a relationship with Jesus!

Associate Pastor Harris preached, "Unmasking Jezebel." The Jezebel spirit seeks to hide itself, while seducing, intimidating, and manipulating. Its goal is murder. It trades in human souls. We speak of the "Jezebel spirit" because it is the kind of spirit that in ancient times worked powerfully through Queen Jezebel, a Sidonian princess (married to King Ahab of Israel) who killed many prophets of God. Jezebel is later mentioned in Revelation 2:20, in the context of the church of Thyatira. There she was called a false prophetess and a teacher of sexual immorality. It would seem there that Jezebel is a name for a person who is under the influence of that spirit, because the Word says the Lord gave her time to repent. This "queen of heaven" / "Jezebel spirit "/"Mystery Babylon"/" harlot spirit" is a very religious spirit, vet it promotes religious things that are contrary to God. It promotes fleshly indulgence by God's people and shunning of the cross. The Jezebel spirit is the enemy of the true prophets of the Lord. The Book of Revelation has a chapter almost exclusively devoted to exposing this spirit (chapter 17). There we read that the woman is drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus (Revelation 17:6). So this spirit especially hates and seeks to murder righteous people and those who speak faithfully the Word of the Lord, just as ancient Jezebel, the wife of Ahab, was responsible for killing most of the true prophets of God in her day (I Kings 18:13). God has sent a prophetic word to Elder Harris that the Lord is helping our pastor and leaders to expose and defeat the spirit (prince) of this area that has withstood us. God is giving us victory! Examine yourself carefully to see if you are truly in the faith.

Metro Missionary Anthony Ens preached "Don't Choke The Word" from Mark 4:20. Jesus taught a parable about the souls of people, in which he said there are four kinds of ground in which the seed is sown. The seed is the Word of God. Three out of the four kinds of soil presented or permitted hindrances that stopped the Word from germinating and fully creating the new creature desired by God. There is nothing wrong with the seed. There is power in the Word! The problem, when there is one, is in the soil—or in other words, in us. We must be careful to not let the cares of life grow up like weeds of the heart, choking out the tender plant springing forth from the seed of the Word. The spiritual DNA of the Lord is present in His Word. If we will let Him be formed in us, we can and will be transformed into glorified immortals that are closer imitations of the perfected humanity that we find in the Son of God, Jesus Christ our Lord.
