## Last Sunday AM

Elder Hoskins preached, "Love Never Runs" using John 15:9-17 and Matthew 7:24-26 for his texts. Love never runs away from anybody. We live in an unstable world, but God's love is stable. No matter what place or condition we're in, God's love is always available. If we hear Jesus' sayings and do them, we are like a wise individual who builds his house on a rock. Rains, floods and winds come, but when you're built on the solid rock, you're not going to collapse. God's love will hold you secure. If we build on the rock of Jesus, that love of God will allow us to stand. The Holy Ghost will give you stability.

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Here Comes the Rain - Part 2" using the Book of Joel for his text. The Lord led Pastor Joseph to pick up preaching where Elder Harris Jr left off the last time he preached under the title "Here Comes the Rain." The Lord has decreed a special connection between the nation of Israel (the Jewish people) and the land He promised to them. When they are in the land and they are serving God faithfully, He promised to bless them by blessing their land. Whenever they betray Him, then He permits them to be taken from their land. Whenever they are not present on the land, it is cursed. The Book of Joel is one of many prophetic passages in the Old Testament in which God promised to bless the land of Israel after the restoration of the Jews to the land, and the land to the Jews. The prophecy refers largely to the Millennial Kingdom Age. Yet we know that all millennial prophecies have dual-fulfillment, and that the spiritual fulfillment is for the Church Age. God is going to send us a great revival and great blessing! He will restore the years the locust and cankerworm have eaten! Get ready for the blessing! Have faith for end-time revival. Rain is coming!

## Wednesday

Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached "Cut the Head off the Giant!" using I Samuel 17:31-58 as his text. We've all dealt with giants such as worry, doubt, fear, anxiety, depression, or insecurity. We've wandered through dry valleys looking for answers. Sometimes we come up empty. We feel like David standing in the shadow of Goliath. We have a choice. We're faced with a question: Who are we relying on to defeat our giants? Here are three strategies for battling your giants: (1) Never assume that what worked for somebody else to defeat their giant will automatically work for you. (2) Trust first in the Lord and not just in the weapons you've been given. (3) Celebrate your victories. All of the giants that we battle are designed to bring us closer to God. We can't go into battle to build up an impressive record of wins or go thinking that we'll fight the battle under our own strength. This is simply a call from God to stand up to the giants in our lives, and to be faithful to the Lord as we battle. Have you given your battles to God? Or are you still fighting your giants on your own? We need to echo the call of David, "The battle belongs to the Lord."

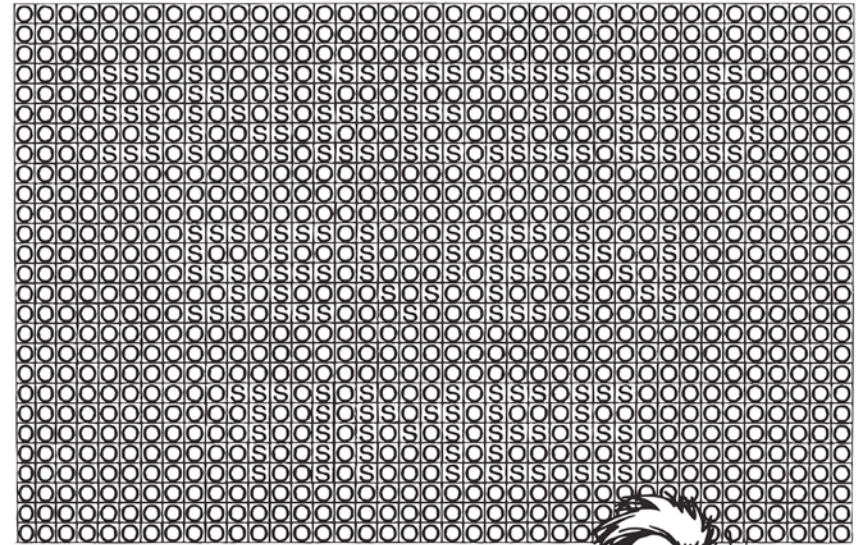

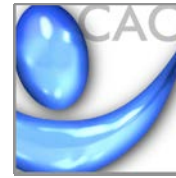
