#### Last Sunday AM

Elder Keith Fought preached "Before You Can Build Up, You First Have to Tear Down" using Joshua 6:1-5 as his text. We all have walls in our lives that keep us from getting closer to God and keep us from growing and getting the victory we need. In order to get past our troubles we must get past those walls. So we must worship and shout down those walls with praise. Once they are down we need to not pick up or restore any piece of that wall. Instead, we need to build on our relationship with God through prayer and Bible study. Rather than trying to tackle our problems on our own, we ought to let Him take care of our problems.

#### Last Sunday PM

Elder David Harris Jr, our Associate Pastor, preached "Let's Take a Walk with Jesus" using II Corinthians 5:7-8 as his text. Many times we face challenges in life that can be very detrimental to us unless we keep our focus on Jesus and approach our life through faith in God. Whenever you are hindered by demonically motivated people, or whenever you find yourself entrenched in a battle of spiritual warfare, it is easy to lose perspective and have your attitude soured. In such times, it is so important to take a walk with Jesus and see what He has to say about the matter. If we walk in the Spirit, we will not fulfill the lusts of the flesh (see Galatians 5:16). God will give enough power to His own to make it through all challenges and oppositions, as long as we rely on His strength and don't try to take matters into our own hands, from a carnal perspective. His destiny for us is greater than anything we could build or accomplish in our own power.

#### Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught an informative lesson about the differences between the Bible's teaching on Creation and the world's false teaching called Evolution, using Genesis 1:1-8 as his main text. Topics covered included the age of the **Earth** (relatively young, versus extremely long), and the popular vet controversial topic of dinosaurs. Many scientific evidences have been shown that prove a relatively young age for the Earth (disproving the "deep time" myth popularized by the Evolutionary crowd, and making Darwinian evolution utterly implausible), and incontrovertible scientific evidences have been shown that prove that dinosaurs and man indeed lived on the Earth at the same time, disproving Evolutionary notions that the process of evolution separated dinosaurs and humans by a minimum of 65,000,000 years. One example: Mary H. Schweitzer, a paleontologist, obtained actual soft tissue from a thigh bone of a T-Rex, which still contained the creature's blood vessels and even some partial proteins. Pastor Joseph recommended a video documentary that can be watched free of charge on YouTube, entitled "Dragons Vs. Dinosaurs," and he also recommended the websites of both the Institute for Creation Research (www.icr.org) and Answers In Genesis (www.answersingenesis.org).






