Last Sunday (one service only, at 2 pm, due to bad weather)

Pastor Joseph preached "The Wonderful Name of Jesus" using Exodus 20:7, Isaiah 45:23, and Philippians 2:10 as well as other verses. The name Jesus means "YHWH-is-Salvation" (or "Yahweh-is-Salvation"). One of the Decalogue's commands is "Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD [YHWH] thy God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain." Although it is problematic and damaging to take in vain any title for God, such as Lord, God, Christ, etc. misuse of the name of Jesus is particularly egregious, as this firm commandment of God regarding the Old Testament name of God the Father (YHWH or Yahweh) pertains directly to Jesus name. There's not a problem when we're talking to people about Him or teaching people about Him or speaking directly to Him. The problem comes when people use either His name, or titles for Him, in expletive fashion when their expletive could've been what replaced with "drat" or "ouch" or "wow." Whenever so-called entertainment has bad language, especially taking God's name in vain, we should avoid it. We should defund such wickedness by boycotting such products.

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson about the Calling of God, using Matthew 28:19-20, Ephesians 4:11, and many passages in Acts. The fivefold ministry (of apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers) comprises gifts by God to the church to perfect the saints for the work of the ministry. All the saints are to do the work of the ministry. Ministry means service. There are many, many ways to serve, and all of us have a purpose in God's plan. If you don't know your calling, then you need to seek God and find out your calling. Regarding the calling of God, there are times when God has revealed to others something of his plan for someone (in addition to that person directly). This can allow people to confirm and corroborate the calling of God. However, God does not always do so. Sometimes he speaks directly to the called and expects them to answer. Don't waste your life not obeying God's call just because you expected human confirmation or corroboration. On judgment day you would be left without excuse. The gifts and calling of God are irrevocable (Romans 11:29). The Great Commission to go everywhere and teach everyone, is applicable to us all. The telling of it in Matthew 28 has a parallel in Mark 16, which says to "go" and teach all, and that the signs shall follow "them that believe" (not just preachers)!



