### Last Sunday AM

Elder Godwin preached "I Am Second." God commands us to place Him first in our lives. We too often get mixed up and allow the world, jobs and other things to remove Him from first place. There are too many Christians living double lives, trying to live in the world and in the church. But if we are to truly affect the world for the Lord and His truth, we've got to be totally committed. We should strive to be known as Christians first, with "what we do" being a lower priority, not vice versa. Jesus told us that no man having put his hand on the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom (Luke 9:62). We've got to be totally committed to the kingdom of God if we are going to fulfill our calling. He must be first; I am second!

### Last Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Thirsty" from Psalms 42 & 43, which are apparently meant to be combined into a single prayer. The psalmist wrote, "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God" (Psalm 42:1). We are broken by the sin curse, but the Lord God can fix us. What's more, He wants to fix us. He intends to, if we will only let Him. In spite of the fact that we're broken, we are still unique, still made in His image, still made for His glory, and still made for a special purpose (individually) in His kingdom. He longs to have a wonderful relationship with us. As soon as we realize how broken we are and how much He loves us, we can rise up, seek Him out, and be touched by His Spirit. Those who know that they are broken and who know that He can fix them, are those who are hungry and thirsty for righteousness. The Lord Jesus promised, "Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled" (Matthew 5:6). He also promised, "Whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life" (John 4:14). And again, "He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water" (John 7:38). Lord we are thirsty for You! We thirst for the living water that only you can give us! We thirst for your Spirit!

### Last Wednesday

CAC's former pastor, Bro Terry Null, preached on "Sowing in a Strange Place and Reaping a Harvest in a Strange Time" using 1 Kings 17 as his text. During a time of drought and famine, God caused the prophet, Elijah, to be fed by ravens, of all things, and to be watered by a brook called Cherith, which name means "cut" as in, "to cut apart a sacrifice and pass between the pieces while entering into a covenant." Thus, by extension, the name means "covenant" and also "be freed." Yet the word can also mean "destroy" or "consume" or "perish." The trials and tribulations we suffer can either make us or break us, depending on how we respond, which depends on whether or not we have faith. Eventually, God took Elijah even further in His test and blessing, by having the brook Cherith to dry up (be "cut" off), and Elijah was led to move on. Finally, God led the prophet to be sustained by a woman—and not a rich, well-cared-for wife, but rather a poor widow. God required humility and obedient faith from both the prophet and widow, and He caused the oil and meal to multiply! He is able to provide for you/us from outside your/our own resources! Have faith!





Left: At Masada, in Israel: A scale model showing what King Herod's multilevel palaces and military installation looked like during its zenith. The model depicts details of a fortress positioned atop a high mountain, overlooking the Dead Sea. The very meaning of the name Masada is "fortress." Interestingly, the model itself is positioned high atop the mountain too, right within the ruins of the ancient site, which is best known for the "Siege of Masada" by troops of the Roman Empire, which led to the mass suicide of the Jewish Sicarii rebels that had taken over the site. It is amazing!
