Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught Lesson 2 of CAC's Pentecostal Distinctives Series, "The Doctrine of Jesus Christ." Topics included the identity of Jesus Christ and the incarnation. Jesus is God incarnate. Jesus is the Son of God — not the eternal Son; not God the Son. Literal meaning: begotten of God. Figurative meaning: bears the nature of God. He has dual nature (deity/humanity). Thus we see twofold references; such as the prayers of Christ, and the greetings in the Epistles. There is one God and one mediator between God and humans, the man Christ Jesus. Jesus is the Father incarnate. Jesus is Yahweh (aka "Jehovah") incarnate. Notice the many scriptural comparisons, such as: Yahweh is the Lord and Jesus is the Lord. Same goes for: Rock, Light, Shepherd, Creator, Redeemer, King, Judge, First and Last, etc. The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus. There is one divine throne and One on the throne. The "right hand" is not a physical location but signifies power, authority, glory, and mediation. The Lamb symbolizes the incarnation and atonement. The Lamb comes out of the throne, returns to the throne, and is seated on the center of the throne. Jesus is the One on the throne. God and the Lamb is one being, on one throne, with one supreme name and one face. Jesus is both God and the Lamb at the same time. He has the highest name, and He is the image of the invisible God. Thus, in eternity we will see Jesus as the visible revelation of the one God. In the incarnation, Jesus Christ was and is both deity (God) and humanity. Acknowledging His deity is essential. Only if Jesus is God does He have power to forgive sin. Jesus also has perfect, sinless humanity. On His mother's side, He is a descendant of Adam and Eve, Abraham, David, and Mary. He has Human flesh (identity, personality). He is human in body, in soul, in spirit, in mind, in will. He was tempted in all points as we are. He has perfect, sinless human nature (as was originally created by God).

Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached "Jesus is Coming to Dinner" from Genesis 18:1-10, Mark 8:2-9, John 6:5-12, and Luke 19:2-6. In Genesis, the Lord God appeared (via an angelic manifestation, also called a theophany) unto Abraham and Sarah, and He had dinner with them at their invitation. In the selected passages of Mark and John, the Lord Jesus would not send the crowds away hungry, so He miraculously provided dinner for thousands of people. In Luke, the Lord Jesus took time to eat dinner with Zacchaeus, a sinful man. In the ancient Near East, having a meal with someone was a big part of friendship and fellowship. The Lord is willing to come to dinner with us, bestowing on us His miracles, provision, anointing, healing, fellowship, and friendship. Let's keep our spiritual house clean for Him!

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught "Knowing God's Word" (part 1). God's Word is: living and powerful, a discerner of the heart, Heb. 4:12; a weapon against evil, Eph. 6:17; our guide to salvation; inspired of God; and our guide to Christian living, II Tim. 3:15-17. Psalm 119 is a 22-stanza poem about God's Word. In it we read that God's Word: brings blessing; leads to truth; cleanses from sin; guards against sin; gives hope; provides direction; and brings peace. In relationship to God's Word, we are to: learn

(read and study) it; meditate upon it; remember it; obey it; rejoice and delight in it; and love it. In prayer on God's Word, we need to: ask God to help us understand His Word; ask God to help us desire His Word; and mix the Word with faith (Heb 4:2).

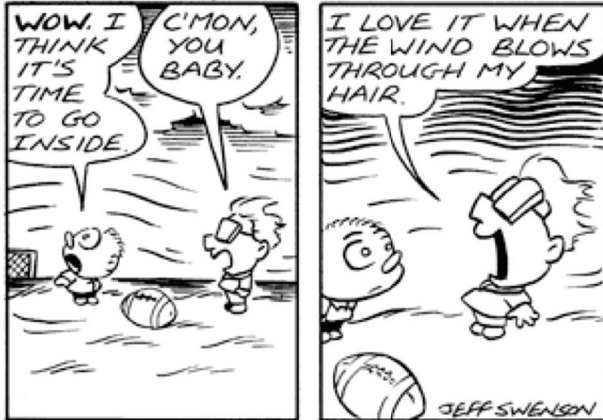

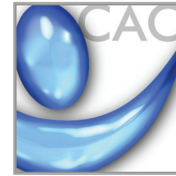
