Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught lesson 4 of the Pentecostal Distinctives Series, “The Gospel of Jesus Christ.” The Gospel is the power of God unto salvation (Romans 1:16-17). We receive this saving power by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8-10). Salvation originates in God’s grace (Titus 2:11). Good works are the result of true faith. Saving faith is always obedient faith. Obedience to the gospel is necessary to salvation (John 14:15; Rom. 6:17; Heb. 5:9; 11:7-8). Those who do not obey the gospel will receive eternal judgment, (II Thes. 1:8; I Peter 4:17). Saving faith includes obedience (Rom. 1:5; 10:16; 16:26). Saving faith is defined as: accepting the gospel of Jesus as the sole means of salvation, and applying the gospel personally by obedience. A summary of the Gospel is found in I Cor. 15:1-4. It is that (1) Jesus died for our sins, paying the penalty for us, and (2) He was buried in the tomb (signifying the finality of His death and reality of His resurrection), and (3) He arose on the third day, winning victory for us. He is our perfect sacrifice of atonement to take away our sins (Mat. 26:28).

This service was signally blessed of God with strong anointing and freedom in the Spirit. Pastor Joseph preached a powerful message entitled “The Rest” using Isaiah 11:1-10 and Hebrews 3:7-19, 4:1-11, and 11:1-11. The Lord’s rest shall be (and is) glorious! Some people seem to want to get God and put Him in a box, to carry Him into their petty life and carnal existence, but God calls us to get up and get out of that world, and to go enter into His rest (just as He called Abram out of Ur). The Lord has a great and wonderful place in Him for each of us, but we must be willing to leave our current “location,” basing our move on trust and faith and heading out without knowing exactly where He is taking us, yet trusting His heart and knowing that He will eventually take us into His glorious rest. Abram, later known as Abraham, arose and left Ur as God commanded. The scripture says he “went out, not knowing whither he went.” That is faith! By contrast, in the word of God a hardened heart of doubt is described as an “evil heart.” The enemy seeks to discourage us and delay us from reaching God’s will for us, but the word of the Lord says “Today if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts.” In one sense, we are on our way to the rest (Heaven), yet in another sense, our New Covenant relationship with God and His church allows us to experience peace and rest during this current age! The Lord grants us blessings and a peace that passes understanding. A peace that the world cannot give! His rest!

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached “The Power of Getting Back Up!” using Micah 7:1-20 and Proverbs 24:16. The prophet Micah lamented the terrible darkness of the times in which he lived, and the backslidden state of God’s people. In despair and depression, he felt completely fallen. Yet he declared in faith, “Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a light unto me.” Even if we slip and fall, spiritually speaking, we can take confidence in the Lord’s love for us and His desire to help us. Based on that strength, we can get back up again and again. We only seal our fate as a failure when we refuse to repent and get back up again. Staying down is a trait of the wicked. The righteous will rise!


