
Wednesday, August 1 - ASR National Rally in session at CAC

Rev. Robert Knight, vice president of the Azusa StreetRiders Motorcycle Ministry, preached "Overcoming the Road Hazards of Life" using Revelation 12:11 as his text. We all face obstacles in our path to becoming what God has planned for us. The list of potential road hazards includes a broken heart, a wounded spirit, emotional scars, physical challenges, bitterness over past events, and so on. Regardless of what hinders you, God has made a way for you to overcome! It is a two-part solution: (1) the blood of the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ, and (2) the word of your testimony. God is a gentleman, and will not force His salvation on anyone. One must cooperate with the blood of Christ by expressing obedient faith in order to appropriate God's deliverance. Just as a motorcycle's designed capability to navigate a curve is meaningless unless the rider actually steers, so also God's desire to help us is ignored until we exercise our freedom of will and decide to work with Him.
