#### Wednesday, October 31

Jr. Elder Hannah Sandy preached on "[Re]Building Your Temple" from Ezra 4:1-5, 12-13. God's wayward people were trying to rebuild their temple, but they grew intimidated because their enemies threatened them. They kept delaying on building the temple, and it took longer than it should have. They had the support of King Cyrus, and more importantly, the support of God. Yet they still feared their enemies. Today we are the temple of God. We ought to always build ourselves up in our most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost. Through prayer, Bible study, and church attendance we can grow stronger. The enemy may pretend to be a friend. Use caution regarding what voices you hear. Like Ezra, we lead in revival. Elder Fought preached "Freedom in Christ" using Galatians 5:1-4. Although the Mosaic has important moral values and wisdom, it is not our covenant. Salvation cannot be earned by works, not even if we obeyed all the law of Moses. Just as they were saved by faith, even while working the works of their covenant, we are saved by grace through faith, even as we work the works of our covenant. The Lord has not called us to "legalism" (works-based salvation). The legalism of the first-century Judaizers was described by Paul as a leaven that would leaven the whole lump. Jesus referred to the leaven of the Pharisees. Other sins can also be types of leaven; drama, bitterness, etc., can be spread through a church. Sometimes things need removed if we are to maintain our freedom in the Lord Jesus Christ.

#### Wednesday, November 7

Jr. Elder Rusty Sandy preached on praise, from Psalm 150. We praise God in all things. He is always in control. Regardless of our circumstances, God is able to supply all our needs. We should praise Him as though each breath was our last! It is only due to God that we have a job, food, clothing, housing and health. Thanks be to God who always causes us to triumph! Paul and Silas were commanded to not preach in, or exalt, the name of Jesus, yet they did the opposite. When they were imprisoned for it, they gave great praise to God! The foundation of the prison was shaken, and they were set free! Stephan was stoned, yet he gave praise to God. Elder Godwin preached about running with patience the race that is set before us, from Hebrews 12:1. In the Book of Acts, great persecution had an effect opposite of that intended by the enemy. Instead of stopping the Church, it caused the Church to spread the Gospel more than ever before. The scripture shows that a great audience of witnesses encircles us in the race, and that we should lay aside anything and everything that might hinder us. This leads us to a crucial question: "Am I doing the very best I can?" So long as we have not yet reached everyone with the truth, we still have more to do. Amazingly, 30% of Americans have no no religious affiliation. That means that one out of every three people we meet is unchurched! We have a massive mission field right here in the USA. Are we doing our very best? We have about 94,000 souls within a three-county area that we need to reach. Let's stay focused on our priority: a burden for winning lost souls!
