Pastor Joseph preached "Table #37" from Psalm 34:8. Jesus has a table spread where the saints of God are fed. Many people miss out on the good spiritual food that He has prepared for them. We need to be more concerned about living spiritually than naturally. We need to come to church to worship and praise God and eat from His table.

Pastor Joseph preached "Tithing: A Practice of Faith" from Luke 6:38 & Malachi 3:10-12. We are to love God with all that we are; mind, body and soul. We are not to compartmentalize and only serve God with portions of our lives. He doesn't want us to be half in and half out. In the beginning man lived in paradise with only one tree that he wasn't to eat from. When he ate of the fruit of that tree he brought a curse upon himself. That curse survives to this day. God allows us money as a way to make a living. All He asks us to give back to Him is ten percent. The practice of tithing is an act of faith. It was practiced by the people of faith before Mosaic law commanded men to tithe. Will a man rob God? Tithing is the first fruit of our increase, and an offering is anything we give over and beyond this. When we tithe, we remove the curse from off of our finances—God will rebuke the devourer for our sakes. Whenever we don't tithe, we're still subject to our curse.


