Elder Godwin preached from Genesis 29:32-35. Leah (the older of two sisters) was not as attractive to Jacob. He was smitten with Rachel (the younger sister). The girls' father had to 'trick' Jacob into marrying the older first, before he was finally permitted to marry the younger too. But while Rachel went as barren for the longest time, Leah gave birth to one son after another. In each of the first three births, she named that son with a focus on hopefully gaining the true love and devotion of Jacob. Only in the birth of the fourth son did she finally give up on pleasing man, by determining to praise God in spite of her circumstance of being the lesser-loved wife. For the longest time, her attention was focused on the negative in her situation, instead of the positive. This was reflected in the naming of the sons, and the parents' views of the sons affected who they became in their older years. Parents, be careful how you speak to and think of your children. Your attitudes and words are shaping them for life! The two most stark examples of the sons are Rueben and Judah, the former thought little of, and he lived down to those perceptions, and Judah, thought highly of and he lived up to those perceptions. Let us always seek to focus on the good and not dwell on the bad!

Sis. Hannah Sandy preached "Who Do You Serve?" from Jude 1:4-11 & 17-19 and I John 5:21. People in this world are serving gods who can do nothing for them. There is only **one** God who can do all things. We need to give God our all. Anything we put before God is an idol. We need to give Him 100% of ourselves. 
