## Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "The River of Life" using II Corinthians 5:16-17 and Revelation 22:1. Whenever are made new in Christ, the cursed, depraved creature we once were, ceases to exist. By the touch of Jesus, through the miracle of His indwelling Spirit, we are transformed. We become the most wonderful, most noble, most beautiful, spiritual, sweet, loving, caring, and blessed being. We become an advanced type of human, a creature fit to exist in a perfect realm where the curse is gone. If we fall back into the old lifestyle, we slowly kill off that beautiful being He made us into. We murder that noble and glorious creature, allowing a zombie-like renewal of the cursed man or woman of debauchery and shame to crawl from the tomb alive again to sin. It's like the dog returning to eat its own vomit. In such a state, we could not accomplish anything good for the Lord. We would utterly lack the anointing and power needed to effect a victory. To that carnality, we say no! We are the anointed children of God! We are the people of the Book! We are the Spirit-filled, blood-bought Bride of Christ! We have His name! We are filled with His glory! There is a River of Life flowing through us! We are ambassadors of Christ! *Bro. Jesse Vitt was powerfully renewed in the Holy Ghost during this service.*

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached about the baptism of Holy Ghost and how to receive this wonderful gift, using Joel 2 and Acts 2 as his texts. He had a time of testimony from both Elder Baron Claypool (healed of Celiac Disease) and Jr. Elder Zach Sandy (resurrected from death). Both gave detailed, anointed testimonies about their miracles. Pastor Joseph then explained that the baptism of the Holy Ghost is an even more amazing miracle—in fact, the transformation by the Spirit the most wonderful miracle we can receive from God. Several testimonies were given about people who had been baptized with the Spirit. During the altar service *Bro. Caleb Colombo was filled with the Holy Ghost, and at the conclusion of the service he was water baptized in Jesus name! Praise the Lord!*

## Wednesday

Jr Elder Zach Sandy preached on worship, using Job 1:6-12,20-21 and Mark 5:1-6. Satan obtained permission from God to take all that Job had, but even with nothing left, Job found that he still had faith and worship. Some people claim that because they have not had a "great" miracle in their life (such as being raised up from death, like Bro. Zach) that they don't know what they have to praise God for. Consider that if you are breathing, you are blessed! If you have shelter and food and clothing, you are blessed! There are no valid excuses for not worshipping God. The Bible says, "Let everything that hath breath praise the Lord!" Elder Godwin preached "The key to your prison door is praise and worship!" from Matthew 12:37 and Acts 16. Once, long ago, when asking why there was such a difference between "special" church services and regular "flat" services, the Lord

answered that it was in the expectation of the people (or lack thereof). As in Acts 3, we ought to look forward with expectation for what is about to happen! We need to be careful about our thought life and the words we utter, for these shape the mental construct in which we live. We should capture and halt the negatives and doubts, and instead offer praise and worship. Elijah had great power and victory over hundreds of false prophets, but he allowed doubt to cause him to collapse in fear of Jezebel. He was downcast instead of faith-filled. By contrast, Paul and Silas sang and praised God in the middle of a jail cell at the midnight hour, even though they had been beaten and their future seemed bleak. The Lord opened the prison up, and set them free, through their worship and praise!


