Sunday AM – Fresh Oil – time of anointing

Evangelist Mark McCool from Ocean Springs, Mississippi preached a powerful message that was a very beneficial word from the Lord for CAC. His text was taken from the prophetic Book of Habakkuk, chapter 2. The title and theme of the message was “Time to Set the Hook in Your Promise.” The Old Testament prophet wrote, “I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.” When it comes to holding onto faith for God’s promises to us, we must be very determined to stand our ground. Some people give up and “cut their line” just when they were about the catch their big prize fish. Likewise, people often have given up and backslid just before a delivering miracle from God was manifested. We’ve got to set the hook and then stay the course! Don’t give up!

Sunday PM – Fresh Oil – time of anointing

As our series of special services concluded, this service was an amazing grand finale. Evangelist Mark McCool from Ocean Springs, Mississippi again preached his heart in an unforgettable message entitled, “Why Settle for a Blessing When You Could Have the Victory” using II Kings 13:1-25 as his text. The young king over God’s wayward people was on the threshold of a what would have been a profound revival produced by a military deliverance from the enemies that held the people in bondage. However, it was not to be, because the young king settled for a blessing instead of pressing toward total victory. The aged prophet, very near death, tried to bring the victory to the king’s hand by telling him to shoot the arrow of the Lord’s deliverance and then to smite the ground with the arrows. But the king only smote thrice and stayed. As a result of his half-hearted obedience, the people of God only won three battles, and lost the war. Serve with all your heart!

Wednesday

As the hand of God directed, the two Elders who spoke this night took their texts from the same chapter, one passage right after the other. The Lord does all things well. Elder Hannah Sandy preached from Kings 4:1-7. She brought forth several testimonies of God using anyone who was willing and obedient. The selected passage of Bible verses conveyed that the poor widow woman (about to lose her sons to debtor’s prison after losing her husband to death) had nothing save a pot of oil. It was enough! Vessels were borrowed no matter size or condition. Just one pot filled all those vessels. The Lord does not use only the perfect and pretty vessels. He can fill and use chipped, cracked, seemingly useless vessels. He only needs a willing soul that will be obedient. God will use us if we let Him! Elder Keith Fought preached a message of determined faith entitled “It is Well” from 2 Kings 4:8-28, especially noting 4:26. When it seems like all is lost, hold onto faith and say with confidence “It is Well!” No matter how dead the Lord’s promise seems, He is able to resurrect the potential just as he raised the only son of the Shunammite woman. Hang on with determination! It IS well!!

What are some words that we can use to praise Jesus? Circle all the sentences below that are praise sentences. Then color the picture of Jesus.




- Thank you God for sending Your son.


