Former Pastor Terry Null preached "Go Forward" from Exodus 14. The tiniest seed sown can return a thousand fold. Don't let drought around the seed affect faith. There are times when we must wait upon God. Spend such times in praising God. God is not a "microwave" God. He hears our cries and prayers. When our troubles are out of our control, they're in God's control. God will give us strength to worship Him in the presence of our enemies. In Exodus, the children of Israel had just been delivered from a hard life in Egypt. But now they are camped between two mountains (a swamp and bitter water) with the Red Sea in front of them and the Egyptian army pursuing after them. God's protection was with them. God will take care of the enemy that's been a thorn in your flesh. It's time to speak to the situation and keep praising Him. As long as you look back, you can't go forward. We must embrace God 100% or we'll always live on the border. Go forward in faith knowing that God is always with you.

Former Pastor Terry Null preached "It's Going To Be Alright" from II Kings 4. Elisha had been to the woman's house; she had prepared him a room; he told her through God that she would have a son. Later, her "promised son" died. She had a circle of voices going through her mind presumably offering sympathy. Yet she had faith that "it shall be well." She determined to go to the man of God. When Elisha saw her approach, he sent his servant to her to ask her how the child was. She answered, "It is well," even though he was dead. Don't let fear take over. Fear will make you cave in and crash. Fear doesn't help tomorrow's trouble; it only makes today's trouble worse. When Elisha got to her house he stretched himself over the child, and the child rose from the dead. Let the faith of the man of God come to your situation and be stretched over your troubles. By faith, "It is well!"

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Revival Continues" from Acts 2:42-47. We must not lose revival spirit after an evangelist leaves. Revival must continue in our hearts. 


Marching Around Jericho


