Elder Lorren Godwin preached "How Bad Do You Want It?" from I Chronicles 16:11. If we really want something we will seek God until it happens. We allow things—such as computers, TV, Facebook, our jobs, and our friends— absorb our time. We really don't seek God as we should. Forsake everything, fall on your face and cry out to God. Seek Him with your whole heart. Be desperate. Let nothing come between you and God. No matter what it takes or costs, God must be the top priority in your life. Sunday PM

Missionary Richard Porter preached from Ephesians 1:7-12. Missions is not just going to a foreign country. Missions is right here in our hearts. Everyone has a calling to go and tell others that there is a God who loves them. We have a mission to spread this message of peace, joy and hope to a dying world. We have a mission to get on our knees and touch the Throne of God for souls. If we would do what God has called us to do, the church would be on fire. Look in the mirror: **you** have a calling of God in your life.

Wednesday

Rev. John F. Harrison taught the first part of our seminar on finances. The topic for this night was how to best utilize Social Security to enhance your retirement options. The session was excellent and provided a wealth of beneficial info.

Saturday

Rev. John F. Harrison taught the second part of our seminar on finances. The topic for this day was how to retire the right way. The title was "You Can Take It With You." Of all the paradoxes in the Bible, one of the clearest is that you cannot take any worldly possession with you to heaven, except in one sense: If you selflessly use earthly goods to love people, help the poor, etc, you will build up a reward in heaven. Bro. Harrison explained that when people die, most of them (even so-called blue-collar or "regular" people) leave an fairly large estate—the combined value of life insurance payouts, retirement account, home, cars, etc, totals on average about \$225,000. Christians ought to tithe on their estate. Most never do, neither while they're alive nor after death, in spite of the fact that it is "increase" to them. One amazing way to tithe on an estate is through getting a very affordable (\$20-\$25 per month) life insurance policy (permanent/whole life, not term) and set the church as the owner and beneficiary. It will accrue a cash value that the church has access to, and if the saint passes on, the payout to the church is usually far more than the saint paid in premiums. This is a great way to fund the work of God!


- **Voice of Truth** is aired each Sunday at 11:30am on **News/Talk WAJR 103.3 FM**.

Who Is Your True Father


In the puzzle below there are different numbers, and in the numbers are hidden letters. Find the letters and discover who your true father is?


