#### Fireworks Tent - Fundraising Project Update

As you may already know, our Wednesday night service was cancelled due to extenuating circumstances at the fireworks tent. A major show of commercial grade fireworks was presented from the hill behind K-Mart. It attracted a huge crowd of spectators. This presented for our tent both challenges (such as being on guard against shoplifters and against anyone setting off personal fireworks near our tent, which occurred on some occasions and we had to be vocal against it) and blessings (the crowd caused a notable increase in tent traffic and customers). This resulted in the tent having a very good "July the 3<sup>rd</sup>," sale total. Then, on Thursday we had the best "July the 4<sup>th</sup>" sale total in the history of CAC having a tent. Every year the TNT company sets a sales goal for each tent. This year they established three tiers of prizes for tents that exceeded their projected goal by \$600, \$900, or \$1,000. Our tent exceeded our projected goal by over \$2,500! We came the closest to selling out that we have ever seen. Our returns (only 10 boxes) fit in the back of a minivan without even removing any seats! It will take about 30 days for the TNT company to finalize their accounting and settle what monetary awards our tent earned, but our early calculations indicate that our tent will net between \$7,000 to \$8,000 this year, toward our construction project. Thank you to all who helped!




