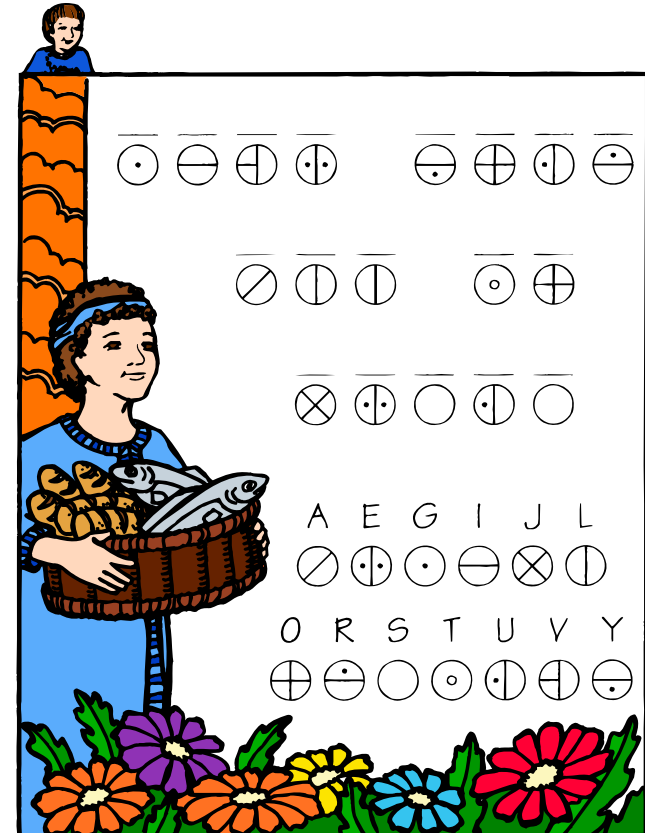

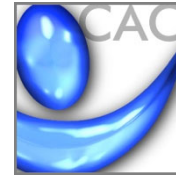

This past Thursday, July 11, 2013, was the one-year anniversary of Zach's miracle of being raised from the dead after being killed by lightning. The date was officially declared as "Zach Sandy Day" by a proclamation of the Harrison County Commission. Previously, on June 30, the Clarksburg Exponent-Telegram newspaper ran a front-page story noting the book launch and mentioning the anniversary celebration. Afterward, on July 12, WV Public Broadcasting aired Zach's testimony. Also, Connect-Clarksburg.com ran a pre-story and a main story in conjunction with the 1-year anniversary. Yesterday, July 13, 2013, the Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN – home of the 700 Club) informed Bro. Bud Sandy (Zach's father) that the miracle testimony has been approved for filming to be aired on the network. The producers are excited about it. Bro. Bud said, "Zach is going to tell the world that Jesus is alive and on the throne and still performing miracles!"
