Pastor Joseph taught on "Water Baptism" starting with Acts 10:42-48. Key biblical examples of baptism are John's baptism and the baptism of Christ. John's baptism prepared the way for Christian baptism. It was a baptism of repentance unto remission of sins, continued by Christ's disciples before Pentecost. Jesus' baptism endorsed John's ministry and inaugurated Christ's ministry. It fulfilled all righteousness and set an example. Baptism is commanded by Jesus, and it was practiced by the early church. Peter "commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord" (Acts 10:48). Purposes of baptism are: expression of faith in Jesus as Savior, remission of sins, personal identification with Jesus, burial with Jesus Christ, part of spiritual circumcision, part of salvation and part of the New Birth. The biblical mode is by immersion. The biblical formula is in the name of Jesus. Matthew 28:19 refers to the name of Jesus; it is the singular name that meets all qualifications. The Apostles fulfilled this command in the Book of Acts. Today all believers should fulfill this command, weighing obedient faith over tradition.

Pastor Joseph preached "Get Busy Living" from Psalm 115:1-18 & 116:1-19, and 114. Our God is so mindful of us. He will bless those who fear Him. His blessings are to us and to our children. To fear God is to have respect and reverence for Him. If we call upon Him in troublesome times He will deliver us. God is gracious, righteous and merciful. The death of His saints is precious in the sight of the Lord. It is a transition from here to glory. But with the wicked it is not so. Their thinking is upside down. Examples are people who think suicide is cool or people who kill their own babies. This is a sin-sick world. The devil is a liar. We must make up our mind to not get discouraged or give in to the world, but rather to love and serve God. Don't let the world change your thinking. We have a choice to listen to this upside down world or to listen to the Bible. We must keep our mind fixed. We are meant to dwell in Heavenly places at all times. God's peace can ever be with us.
