Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on the gifts of the Spirit titled "The Body of Christ" using I Corinthians 12:12-20 & 14:26. Even as our natural body is one and has many members, so is the body of Christ. The members of our body work together to help or build up our natural body. The church should come together for good to build up the body of Christ. When we come together, we should operate as the Lord wills. Let all things be done for edifying the body of Christ. There are several functions for tongues, which include: (1) the initial evidence of the Holy Ghost baptism, (2) sign to the church that a new member is filled, (3) sign to unbelievers/believers who are not yet filled and (4) a prayer language for Spirit-filled believers and (5) tongues for interpretation. The nine gifts of the Spirit in I Corinthians 12 are: (1) the word of wisdom, (2) the word of knowledge, (3) faith, (4) gifts of healing, (5) the working of miracles, (6) prophecy, (7) discerning of spirits, (8) divers kinds of tongues, and (9) the interpretation of tongues. There are diversities of gifts, but by the same Spirit. Let us all do our part to build up the body of Christ.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Shields of Gold" from I Chronicles 18:7 & 28:9-10, 20-21. We should reverence the things of God. Show respect and take care of the House of God. It is sanctified and special; set aside for a purpose of worship to God. During church is no time to text friends or play on your phone. David fought the enemies. The Lord preserved David wherever he went. God gave David many victories. When David won something to help the House of God, he saved it; it had been in the enemies' hand long enough. He saved brass, silver & gold to build the House of God. David told his son Solomon, "Be strong and of good courage, and do it." Don't obsess over worldly things such as sports. Be concerned about soul winning. David wanted peace and safety for his people; we need to see people born into the Kingdom of God. We need to see people healed. A soul born into the Kingdom of God is a shield of gold in God's house. A soul healed is a shield of gold. Be concerned about seeing more shields of gold in the House of God.

Wednesday

Elder Zach Sandy preached from Matthew 21:33-39 & 22:1-14. Be careful what we allow in our vineyard (our life). A tiny influence can have a great impact on us. Don't live life trying to do just enough to get by. Rather, live to please God in everything you do. Don't let worldliness (music, movies, etc) creep into your lives. Keep the unspotted wedding garment on so you'll be ready when Jesus comes. Elder Lorren Godwin preached from Luke 14:16-23. If we bring people to church, God will fill them with the Holy Ghost. Our job is to go to the world and preach the gospel. Compel them to come in. Put your arm around someone – love them – let them know they are important and God loves them. We cannot turn our nose down to the lost. If we want to win souls we must go **out** and preach the gospel.




Fun! Kids Corner | The Shepherd Boy of Bethlehem - I Samuel 16


