Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Retaking the Planet" from John 14:30. God made Adam ruler of the planet. Adam rebelled against God, and thus gave the devil rule over him. Now man is a sin-cursed creature. He forfeited his role as ruler to the devil. Just as one man, Adam, sold us out, also one man, Jesus, bought us back. We need the help of God to get rid of sin. We must have a goal to mature in God. Then when the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will life up a standard against him. The perfect standard is Jesus. Thus, our goal encompasses making Him our Lord, and keeping Him as our Lord, which makes the devil no longer our ruler. The first man was immensely effective for evil, by choosing to sin against God, while the last Adam, the Lord Jesus, was supremely effective for righteousness by being utterly obedient to the Spirit of God within Him. When we say we want to retake the planet, it must be a declaration that we wish to be found worthy in our Lord's sight to be granted oversight after He has retaken the planet!

Pastor Joseph preached "Never Too Late" from John 4:23-24. God is awesome! His ways and thoughts are much higher than ours. God wants people to worship Him in spirit and in truth. A wayward Samaritan woman was touched when she met Jesus at the well. In those days the Jews had no dealings with the Samaritans. Jesus told her that if she would drink of the water that He gave, she would never thirst. She went away and witnessed to many people about Him. One person touched by God can win the lost more than many people who are not endued by God. Let the Spirit lead you in every aspect of your life, including career, dating, and especially marriage. Always make sure of God's will. If you make a wrong decision, pray. The devil will tell you there is no hope for you, but the devil is a liar. Hold onto God, as He can bring you back, beyond the damage in your life.

Elder Hannah Sandy preached from Leviticus 19:28 & Mark 5:1-10. God has never approved of people cutting themselves or marking themselves. This is one reason why we certainly ought to avoid physical marks and cuts, including tattoos, piercings, cuttings, and any other damaging of oneself. However, we also might spiritually "cut" ourselves off from God when we feel that we can't get past where we were. Lay the past down. God wants to give you a life of peace. He doesn't want you to hurt anymore. (Pastor's note: One who has one or more tattoos on himself or herself from the past can certainly repent and be saved. However, once they have repented and know better, they should avoid getting any new markings.) Elder Keith Fought preached "Conditions of Successful Prayer" from II Chronicles 7:14. There is power in prayer. God wants us to humble ourselves and pray and seek His face. We need to get lost in Jesus. Pray with your whole heart. We need to turn from any sin in our lives and let God renew a clean heart in us. Die out to this world daily. We need to have a successful prayer life.
