Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Name" from Exodus 6:1-3; 3:13-14; and Isaiah 43:3, 11. The Old Testament's "I AM" name of God the Father (*Yahweh*, aka Jehovah; in ancient Hebrew: YHWH), when compounded with the Hebrew word for Savior, and then translated from Hebrew to Aramaic to Greek to Latin to English, is Jesus. "Jesus" means "Yahweh-Savior," or God saying "I AM... the Savior." One can't say "Jesus" without saying the name of God the Father. Jesus Christ is the human manifestation of the Father. Many are steeped in tradition and misunderstanding and don't understand the fullness of the name. They need God's Spirit to reveal it to them. We, the church, must study and always be ready to give an answer. God's Spirit, His Word, and His church speak the same truth. When Moses spoke to God in the burning bush, he asked God, "What is your name?" God told Moses, "I AM that I AM." God the Father also indicated He is the only Savior: "I, even I, am the YHWH; and beside me there is no savior" (Isaiah 43:11). Before Jesus Christ was born, an angel commanded Joseph to "call his name Jesus: for he shall save his people from their sins." Jesus came in His Father's name. Jesus was/is God's own humanity. Jesus declared many "I am" statements in the Gospel of John such as: "Before Abraham was, I am," "I am the living water," and "I am the bread of life."

Pastor Joseph preached "Unity" from Amos 3:1-8 & Ephesians 4:1-13. How can two walk together except they agree? Unity and tolerance are needed to see past areas where we don't see eye to eye. A house divided against itself cannot stand. If we refuse to be around people over disagreements, we are going to find ourselves isolated and lonely. We need to get along with people and have a spirit of unity. As you go about your daily lives have respect for people. We can preach the truth and reach people; just show them respect. Don't delve into your brother's or sister's business and carry tales. Be humble in unity of spirit. Stay full of the Holy Ghost. Don't bear a grudge or carry bitterness. It's God's will for us to forgive one another, to love one another and to serve one another.

Elder Zach Sandy preached from John 16:30-35. In this world we will have trouble and tribulation. But we can have peace through it all because Jesus has overcome the world. When we follow Jesus, He is in front of us. He eliminates things we know not of. Without God we are insufficient. With God we can do all things. When Saul asked David why he thought he could slay the Philistine, David answered that God had delivered him out of the paw of a lion and a bear, and God would deliver him out of the hand of the Philistine. David told the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword and a spear but I come to you in the name of the Lord." The battle is the Lord's. Whatever you are going through, don't face it alone. Give it to the Lord. In all things, turn to God. You can have peace that passes all understanding even in the darkest time in your life.



How Did God Help?


To find out how God's people got the food and water they needed to live in the desert, follow each trail. Copy the letters along each trail into the puzzle boxes.
