Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached from I Samuel 2:12-14. The devil loves to trick and destroy us. The biggest difference between the Lord and the devil talking to us is that the devil condemns us. The Lord talks of love. If we do something wrong, the Holy Ghost lets us know or convicts us. God never condemns. The devil comes to discourage us in three ways: our past, present and future. Don't listen to the devil. We need guides in our life: the pastor, the elders. Trust in Jesus and rely on His Word. When the devil tells you of your past, tell him "I don't have a past." When you are baptized, God washes your sins away. The Holy Ghost makes you a new creature. "Old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (II Corinthians 5:17). We must die out to this world daily. We must constantly serve and worship God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. When he starts talking to you, start to worship and praise God. Let God be in control of your life.

Pastor Joseph preached "New Heart, New Spirit" from Exodus 31:18. Adam's and Eve's sin caused all our hearts to be cursed, stony hearts. When Moses saw the wickedness of the people dancing around the golden calf, he became angry and threw down and broke the tables of stone on which the Ten Commandments were written. Thankfully, he got over his anger. When "Pastor Moses" cooled down, he pleaded for God to forgive the people. He interceded at the risk of his own salvation. Don't be afraid of your pastor. He is your best friend. He watches for your soul and must give account unto God for you. People are broken and need help. We need to have compassion and pray for them. The Lord spoke through the prophet Jeremiah that He would make a new covenant with the people. He would write the law in their inward parts, would forgive their sins and remember them no more. Through Ezekiel, the Lord prophesied, "And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh" (Ezekiel 11:19). We must hide God's Word in our heart, but we also need the voice of the Holy Ghost and of the church. We need to study God's Word, be faithful to church, and follow the lead of the Spirit.


