CAC heard a presentation from Chris Mullet of the Clarksburg Mission. He told of the importance of God's call on us to help others. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor: He hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised..." (Luke 18-19). When anyone asks of us, we are to give, expecting nothing in return. Elder Keith Fought preached from Hebrews 12:25-29 & 13:5-8. Serve God with reverence and godly fear (respect). Every day things change, but God's Word never changes. It is the same as it was from the beginning of time. "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever" (Hebrews 13:8). After over 2,000 years the plan of salvation is still the same: repent, be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Live a holy life. The Bible is our handbook. Go to church when doors are open. Jesus never changes!

Pastor Joseph preached "Go For It!" from I Samuel 30, and Matthew 11:12. Before David was made king of Israel, he went through a time of wandering in the wilderness, suffering rejection by both Saul and Saul's enemies, the Philistines. While Saul's forces and the Philistines were preparing for battle with each other, and while David and his men were returning from rejection by the Philistines, the Amalekites were taking unfair advantage, kidnapping all their wives and children and stealing all their belongings. David's men wanted to stone David over it. He had the wisdom to inquire of God, and the Lord told him to pursue and that he would recover all. One may stumble into debt, bondage, or sin, but one does not just stumble out. It takes determination and pressing with all your heart to get free. This is the sense of Jesus' words in Matthew 11:12: "...the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force." None of us deserve freedom, but God still says, "Go for it!" Never wait until you deserve salvation. Go for it!

Wednesday

Elder Zach Sandy preached "Stand Up and Stand Out" from I Kings 17:1 & 18:17-24. It's time for God's people to get out of their comfort zone and stand up for God. We can't halt between two opinions or have our heart in two places. There is only one true God. We receive power after we receive the Holy Ghost. We will have power to pray for the sick and they shall recover. We are God's witnesses. Elder Baron Claypool preached "The Open Door" from I Samuel 3:1-15 & I Corinthians 16:8-9. We have an "open door" here in this church where people can come in and hear the Gospel of Christ. Parents, raise your children in the truth. The world is out to suppress our children. We must proclaim the truth. Don't just send your children to church. Let them see you living faithful to God. Because of Samuel's faithfulness God's hand was upon him. If we stay faithful to God, His hand will be upon us. Stand for truth!






