Sunday AM

Elder Les Benedum preached "God's Got Talent" from I Corinthians 12:1-22 & Ephesians 4:11-13. God has given the church gifts to use for His glory and honor: the word of wisdom, the word of knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, the working of miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, divers kinds of tongues and interpretation of tongues. These are to be used to build up the church, not to show off. We are all part of the body of Christ. Each one of us is necessary. The apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers are for the perfecting of the saints, the work of the ministry and the edifying of the body of Christ. God has a ministry for each one of us. The hand of friendship when you go to pray for someone means a lot. CAC has lots of talent. Get up and put your faith in operation. Use whatever talent or ability God has given you to worship Him. God has given every one of us talent. Use your gifts for the body of Christ.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Mercy" from Isaiah 28:1-13 & Matthew 12:15-21. The Pharisees had solid doctrine, but their attitudes were often very wrong. One of their biggest flaws was loving God's *rules* more than they loved *people*. Because of this, they continually challenged Jesus, and were often chastised by Him. The Lord demonstrated that the rules were made for the people, not the other way around! The merciless Pharisees' response? A plot to destroy Jesus because of His mercy. Jesus cited to them, "I will have mercy, and not sacrifice." We will have occasions when enforcement of God's rules is truly necessary, *but sometimes mercy is what is called for*. The only way to discern which one is right in any given instance is *to be guided by love of people*. In the Old Testament God showed a major precedent when he rescued the children of Israel out of Egypt *first*, then gave them the "rules" of the covenant *second*. We should follow this example, and love and help people come to God *first, then* later teach them about God's rules.

Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Victory is Mine" from II Kings 13:18-19. We need full victory, not just a little bit. Pray with all your heart. Instead of trying to get someone else's attention or focusing on ourselves, we need to get God's attention. Don't let the enemy throw things at us: fear, jealousy, depression, sickness, discord. We need to keep our eye on Heaven. Greater is He that is in us than He that is in the world. We are stronger than the spirits the devil tries to put on us. Elder Lorren Godwin preached about us being a light to this world. We had better start acting like we are Christians in this world. People are watching us and listening to us. When we are out in the world, we must be Apostolic. Show love to people who are down. Ask yourself: am I showing the love of Christ to the world?
