Elder Keith Fought preached "God's Word: Our Standard of Faith and Practice." "Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he" (Proverbs 29:18). Be faithful in attendance and study to hold onto the vision God has given. Keep God first. Live by His Word. We are a testimony of what God's done in our life. People should see the Holy Ghost glow in us. If we reject God's Word, we reject God. Which do we look at more, the Bible or Facebook? It is our duty to read and learn God's Word. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (II Timothy 2:15). The Bible is not just a book. It teaches us how we need to live. We need to take time as a family to read God's Word and pray.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Kingdom Citizenship" from Matthew 2:9-15 & 5:1-12. The heart is deceitful and desperately wicked. Our own heart will trick us and lie to us. The most damaging lies are that one is filled with the Holy Ghost when he is not, or that one is born again when he is not. We must be pour in spirit (meaning we recognize our need of God). The Scripture speaks of the fruit (singular) of the Spirit, not fruits (plural). Faking some of the attributes of this fruit does not prove one has the Spirit. Likewise, a truly born-again citizen of the Kingdom of God is called and empowered to display *all* of the Beatitudes, not just some of them. While one might fake a few of them, no one can manifest them all without true help from God. We must receive the Holy Ghost, and stay full of the Holy Ghost! When people realize that they are in need of God, they will come to Him. Godly sorrow worketh repentance. We must be willing to serve. Meekness is not weakness; it is laying aside one's right or power for the benefit of another. Blessed are they who hunger and thirst after righteousness. We mustn't be bitter. We need God to show us mercy, therefore, we must show mercy to others. We need to make peace, if possible, wherever we go. All who live Godly shall suffer persecution. Rejoice and be exceeding glad for great is your reward in Heaven. We need to work out our own salvation with fear and trembling. "If the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?" Since Jesus died on the cross for us, we ought to die out to sin and consecrate our lives to Him.

Jr. Elder Zach Sandy preached from Luke 1: 28-33. There is no age limit on who can be used of God. If God has promised you something, it's going to happen. He promised Simeon that he wouldn't die until he had seen the Lord's Christ. It happened. When the parents of baby Jesus brought Him to the temple, Simeon saw Him. The Holy Ghost is promised to everyone. This is a promise! This is a gift! All one has to do is open up your heart and receive His promise. God's promises are true. Hold onto the promise God has given you.
