Rev. Ashley Vaughn preached "Visiting The Manger" from Luke, chapter 2. The manger is so much more than a "nice" little setting. Rather, it is an opportunity to learn, worship and receive revelation. At the manger scene we consider angels, shepherds and (admittedly much later) wise men. The angels bring us instruction. Jesus wants us to live a straight life. He wants us to straighten out things in our lives that are not pleasing to Him. The baby Jesus was God. When the angels saw Jesus, they were in the presence of God. While there, you don't just see Jesus lying in the manger. You also see Mary (symbolic of seeing the church). The shepherds teach us of worship. They knew the sacrifice of a perfect Lamb: "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing" (Revelation 5:12). The wise men teach us to seek after heavenly things. Study the things of God and you find treasures. Set your affection on things above and let your mind dwell in Heavenly places. Finally, the manger was simply a starting point on our journey to the cross. A sincere visit to the manger will always lead us to a place of repentance and rededication. Let us be ready to worship Him at the manger and all the way to the cross.

Elder Hannah Sandy preached from Mark 15:36. As the centurion watched Jesus suffer and die on the cross, he knew this man was the Son of God. We need to seek after God in all things. We need to tell others about God, instead of just thinking – "they can tell how I live." Tell your loved ones about God. Push harder. Pray that God lets us see how to reach out to people.

Elder Lorren Godwin preached from Matthew 2. When the wise men saw His star, they were looking for the glory of God. When we come to Him, lift Him up. Show the love and mercy of Jesus. The star led them to God's presence. We need to promote Jesus Christ to all men. People will doubt everything they read in the Bible until they experience it. The wise men followed the star and found Jesus, and then they went away talking about Him.

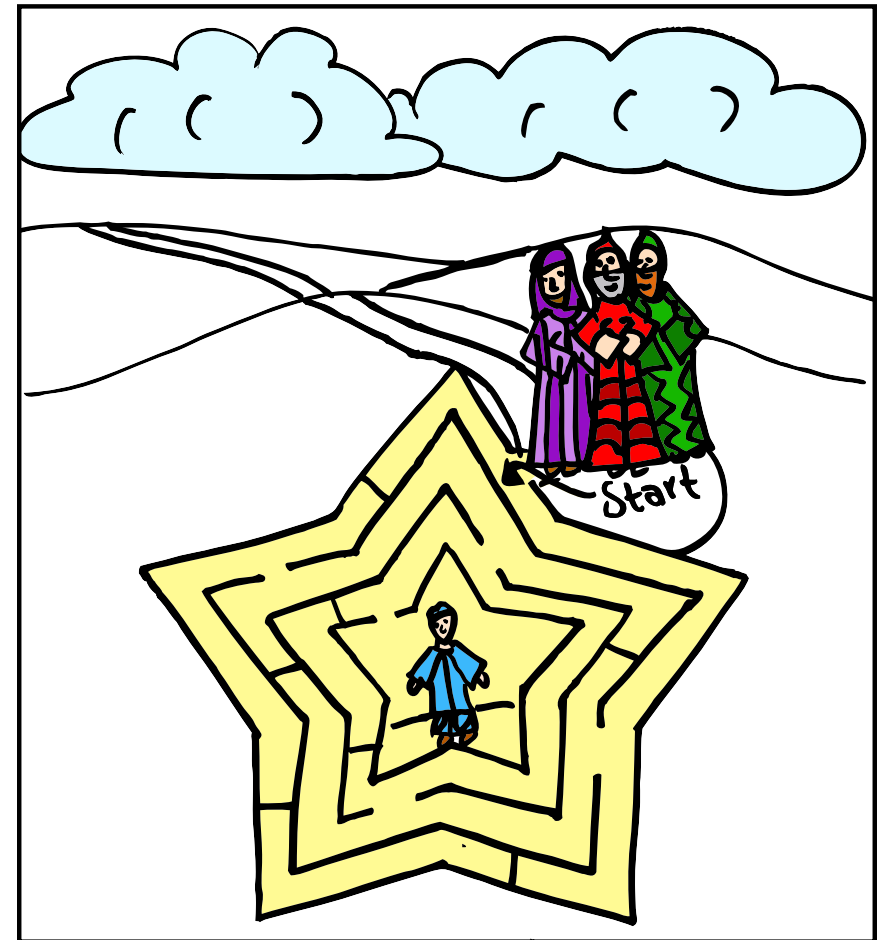

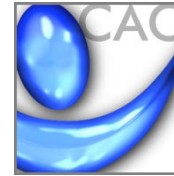
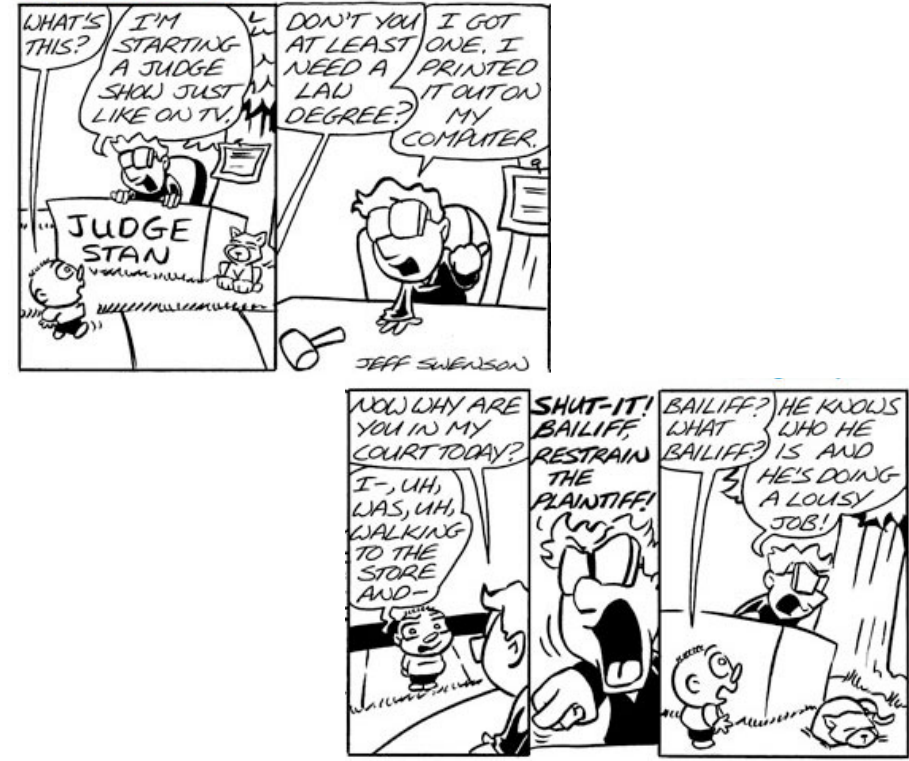
The three wise men have followed the star to find Jesus. Help them move through the maze to find the young child.
