## Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached from Luke 6:45. The words and actions that we use show people who we really are, "for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh" (see the text verse). We act on what we have in our heart. Don't say, "I love you" to someone, and then turn around and tear him down. We need to be more conscious of taking care of our spiritual lives—pray, attend church, read His Word, and think on good things. We need to be filled up with Jesus and give no place to the devil. When people see us—our neighbors, family, classmates or coworkers—they need to see a godly image in us. Seek ye first the kingdom of God. Every thought that we have must be brought into captivity to the obedience of Christ. When a bad thought comes in your mind, don't let it take root. We need to be cautious of the songs we listen to and the TV programs we watch. Are they pleasing to God? We can't be conformed to this world, but must be transformed by the renewing of our mind. We must be different from the world.

# Wednesday




