Sunday at 3pm – This was the 2014 "Sanctity of Human Life Sunday."

Pastor Joseph's message was Pro-Life. God made mankind in His image (Gen. 1:27). All human life is sacred because of this, God's image-bearers must stand against the murder of pre-born children, ghastly science experiments in which babies are made just to be murdered to harvest their organs or stem cells, and euthanasia (ending a life to "relieve pain and suffering") which is the dehumanizing and killing of the elderly, infirm, etc. Ever since 1973, there has been a war on preborn children! Approximately 57,000,000 preborn babies have been murdered in the USA alone, from then to now. This must end. Roe/Doe was baseless, the worst decision in the history of the US Supreme Court. It must be overturned. All that the Supreme Court of 1973 "knew" was wrong. The claim that abortion is safer than childbirth is false. Abortion is the opposite of healthcare. Not only is the preborn baby's life snuffed out, but the woman faces increased risks of breast cancer, future pre-term births, emotional illness, and death (can be from abortion itself, suicide, substance abuse, breast cancer, etc). Mothers who don't abort lower their risks of cancer, PTB, suicide, etc) and statistically have longer life spans, while abortive women statistically have shorter life spans. Elect pro-life candidates. Overturn Roe/Doe. Adoption is a noble alternative. Will our generation end abortion on demand?

They gave praise and had faith in the midst of their trial, and God rewarded them in the end. Through His name, we, too, have deliverance! • Elder Chuck Hoskins preached from Luke 7:36-47. Simon the Pharisee invited Jesus over to his house for dinner, only because he wanted to use the Lord for entertainment purposes, just for show. He offered no water to wash Jesus' feet, and no oil to anoint Jesus' head. This Pharisee lived according to a very high standard of holiness, and yet he did not show very much gratitude or love for the Lord. A sinner woman came into the house. She did not fit in. She didn't belong there. She did not have the right pedigree, the good track record, or the requisite worthiness. She was not forgiven yet, but she praised Jesus as though she had already been forgiven. She washed His feet with tears and dried His feet with her tears. She loved much. Simon the Pharisee judged her, but she was declared by Jesus to be forgiven of her sins. Don't judge others as Simon the Pharisee judged this woman. Leave others to the mercy of God, and live for Him from your heart. We know from this and other similar passages that Jesus is approachable! His love can transcend our shady past! Come to Him, and trust in Him for salvation!
