Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph showed a PowerPoint presentation about three important "rules of thumb" regarding church growth and church buildings. These were "the 80% rule," "the 1:2.5 parking ratio rule," and "the 30 cents on the dollar rule" (which is the national average on initial sale of a built-from-scratch church facility). He then applied these important aspects of understanding to three different church plant situations: (1) our existing facility, which we are currently maxing out with regarding to our parking and thus hitting a growth barrier, (2) a build-from-scratch plan at Lost Creek (expensive to build, and would only allow a little more than double our current size, and then likely be "upside down" in debt, limiting future growth, and (3) the great advantage of buying an existing facility instead. He showed details of an existing facility for sale (1/3 cost of building from scratch), with 23,000 sq. ft. and 350 parking spots. Sat, Mar. 15, CAC saints visited the site.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Jesus On the Inside Working On the Outside" from I John 2:1-28. God is Spirit. God and His own Spirit are not multiple persons. Jesus said, "I and my Father are one." We must have that Spirit, the Holy Ghost, i.e. we must have Jesus Christ in us. We must have the Holy One in us if we are going to be holy. Jesus is our advocate (helper) if we confess that we have a sin problem. Jesus can work in us and help us to conquer our addictions and problems. Jesus can be on the inside working on the outside. He is the only one who can help us gain victory over sin. If we let Him, He will give us a heart that desires the things of God. If you truly love God, you will keep His commandments. People will see Jesus working in you. You will dress holy because you don't desire to be unholy. We are complete in Him. We are to reflect the character of Jesus. We should love one another – not tear others down and sow discord. We are complete in Him. Is Jesus working in you? Look into His Word. It is like a looking glass. It will tell you what's wrong with your life.

Wednesday

Jr. Elder Brian Murphy preached from Exodus 17:1-6, 11-14. Sometimes we grow weary and let down our arms of praise when we are going through tough times and struggles. We question, "God, where are you?" But if we can just praise Him a little longer, the Lord will bring victory. Our battles are in the palm of His hands. Praise Him instead of questioning. Victory comes when we praise Him. Elder Les Benedum preached from I Kings 17:1-6. The Lord commanded ravens to bring Elijah food when there was a drought. God will command help to come. Don't reject that help "just because someone else needs it worse." God seeks those who will worship Him in Spirit and in truth. God blessed the widow woman because she gave to the man of God first. We can't hold onto things of our past and things we are not proud of, if we want to receive the blessings of God. He has many more blessing for us if we will just give our all to Him.


