Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached from Revelation 12:1-8. God's Word tells us to watch for signs in heaven warning us of crucial events. It is foretold (Joel 2:31) the "sun shall be turned into darkness and the moon into blood" before the great and terrible "Yom Yahweh" (Day of the Lord) a day of judgment by Jesus Christ. Occasionally a tetrad of blood moons (four lunar eclipses, back to back, spanning two years) will occur. Rarely, all four of them will fall on Jewish feasts (Passover in the spring and Feast of Tabernacles in the fall). We are now in the midst of such a tetrad for 2014-15. God is sending a signal: a major event is about to happen. The first eclipse fell on April 15 (Passover); the second will be on October 8 (Feast of the Tabernacles). This pattern will be exactly repeated next year. This has only happened three times in more than 500 years—1492, 1949, and 1967. Each occasion coincided with a very dramatic change regarding Jews/Israel. In 1492 the Jews were expelled from Spain, almost immediately followed by the discovery of America, a land that would become a beacon of hope for Jews. In 1949, after Jews suffered a living hell in the Holocaust, the UN recognized the establishment of Israel as a sovereign state. In 1967 there was the Six Day War, which led to the reunification of the city of Jerusalem, the eternal capital the Jewish people. Whatever is about to happen is cause for us to make sure we are ready for Jesus' coming. Just being good is not enough. We must be clothed in His righteousness. We must be partakers of His death (when our sinful nature dies), His burial (when we are buried with Him by baptism in His name), and His resurrection (when we are baptized by the Holy Ghost). Pastor Joseph and Elder Zach Sandy ministered by tag-team preaching. Pastor Joseph preached "Uncharted Waters" from Luke 19:28-35 & John 20:24-29. There is little that people fear more than the unknown. When believers face the unknown, we know the God who knows all! We must trust Him. "Doubting Thomas" didn't believe Jesus was resurrected until he saw Him, but we are "blessed" because we believe even though we have not seen! This involves trusting Jesus even during uncharted waters of our life. We know by faith that in Jesus dwells all the fullness of God. He is alive and His Spirit is in us. We can trust Him when facing circumstances we never faced before. Lazarus died, but the Lord knew he was going to live again. When God has need of you, it means He has bigger plans. All things work together for good for the called. Elder Zach told of his awesome testimony of how he was struck by lightning, was dead for approximately 30 minutes and God brought life back to him. This was done for the glory of God, even as Lazarus' sickness was not unto death. Believers in uncharted waters know that God will be there. Have faith. God is doing something even when you don't see it. Even when you're going through something, declare that God is a healer. Let God be captain of your ship when you are sailing in uncharted waters.

Elder Hannah Sandy preached from Numbers 23:1-11. We should not fellowship with people who pressure us to conform to the world. We must keep our mind focused on God so we won't give in to temptations. Life isn't going to be easy, but we have God

to keep us satisfied. We must be faithful to God—live for Him 24/7. Elder Benedum preached from Jesus' Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard (Matthew 20:1-16) showing that the parable's true meaning has nothing to do with either "Once saved always saved" doctrine or even "foxhole religion" concepts, but rather indicates that by God's mercy, all true believers will enjoy the same eternal reward in Him, regardless of whether some other believers had a greater ministry or endured worse persecution in another time period. The Master's pay at the end of the day is same for all His laborers.


