Elder Lorren Godwin preached "The Blessings of Serving the Real King" from Esther 2:5-9. Worldly people don't care what the Bible says. They choose to please themselves. Mordecai would not bow or reverence Haman, so Haman went to the king and had a law made to destroy all the Jews. However, Mordecai served the real King—he was blessed and his enemy was executed. Each one of us has a choice: am I, or am I not, going to serve God? We need to make up our minds that we are going to serve God no matter what it costs us. We need to stand on what's right. People notice when you do the right thing for the right reason. Mordecai would not bow, and the three Hebrew children would not bow to the golden image.
