Pastor Joseph preached "Hidden and Visible Memorials" from Joshua 4:1-9. God directed Joshua to construct a 12-stone memorial located just past the Jordan River, as a visible witness to future generations of how God dried up the waters of the Jordan until God's people passed over it. Twelve men with strength were selected to build this memorial. Yet Joshua also had another memorial built inside the dry riverbed, which soon became invisible once the waters returned to normal. Likewise, we ought to have both inward consecration and outward displays of our faith. Every day of our lives we are building a memorial. The way we walk, talk, dress, and conduct ourselves in the eyes of man is a memorial. Young ladies, every time you dress modestly it is a memorial. Just as Joshua's memorial was a witness for God, we can build memorials to be a witness for God. We need to get involved more in our culture, in our church and in our family. Make memorials, so when people ask you, "What does this mean?" you can witness to them about God.

Pastor Joseph preached "Open Your Mouth and Let God Fill It" from Psalm 81:1-10, Joel 2:22-32 & Acts 2:16-21, 1-4. We worship the Lord. He is our strength. Joel prophesied that God would pour out His Spirit on all flesh, giving us both the former rain and the latter rain together. On the Day of Pentecost Peter stood up and said "This is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel." God poured out the Holy Ghost and they all began to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. This promise is to every man, woman, boy and girl. God can set you free from drug addiction, cigarettes or anything that has you bound. You must fully surrender your life to Him. God can fix any situation you find yourself in, even if you think it is bigger than you are. 
