Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Trusting God No Matter What" from John 2:1-5. Sometimes we pray and it seems like God doesn't respond as we want Him to. We still need to stand on His promises and trust Him. At the marriage supper Jesus asked His mother what she wanted Him to do. She told the servants "Whatsoever He saith to you, do it." When we pray and He says "No," what do we think? God wants a relationship with us even if He doesn't answer our prayers. He wants us to love and praise Him even when we are down in the valley. In the valley He "restoeth my soul" (Psalm 23:3). Trust God. We can't see the future, but God can. Never doubt the way He answers prayer. He will always be with us. His ways are far above ours. Trust God no matter what. There's always a blessing in obedience. When God speaks, always be obedient even if you don't understand.

All are known by the fruit they bring forth. You need to make up your mind: am I going to be a good man or an evil man? Make up your mind which source you will connect to. We will answer to God for every idle word that comes out of our mouth.



