Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Are You John or Are You Peter?" from John 13:21-24. Peter made noise and got attention, but John was the disciple whom Jesus entrusted with care for his mother as He hung in the cross. John embraced Jesus when Jesus told them he was going to be betrayed. Peter was concerned about who was going to betray Him. Peter denied knowing Jesus when He was arrested and being tried in the palace. John was banished to the aisle of Patmos, a barren, desolate island that was a prison colony for hardened, vicious criminals. Yet while he was there, the Bible says he was "in the Spirit on the Lord's day." He didn't allow contrary circumstances to dictate his attitude. Instead, he received a powerful revelation of things to come. Historians tell us that after he wrote the Revelation, the ruler who had banished him died and a new ruler returned the Apostle John to his home. He eventually died of old age, the only disciple to not be assassinated. Many professing Christians look good and sound good, but a true Christian remains good no matter what the circumstances.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Antimatter" from Acts 10:5-20. Peter was commanded by God in a vision not to consider impure that which God had cleansed. This applied to Gentiles that were at that time about to be brought into the Kingdom as they were to be filled with the Holy Ghost and baptized in Jesus name, but it also means we must not view ourselves as "common" when God has saved us and made us "uncommon." Apostle Paul formerly lived in a way that made him "chief of sinners" yet God used him mightily. Whatever it is in our past that makes us feel that God cannot use us, it all pales in comparison to what the blood of Calvary did to redeem us. Calvary is the antimatter to whatever is the matter with us. God can and will use us, if only we will let Him! We are like Paul; yes we were sinners before Christ, but praise God, we are sinners no more. Our slate has been wiped clean. People may remember our old life and sins but God will not. God has made us "special."

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph exhorted on tithing. We are commanded to tithe – to give God one tenth of our increase. We are to have a covenant relationship with God where we promise Him that we will life a life of obedience, including tithes and offerings. If we tithe, God will bless us. If we don't tithe, there is a sin curse upon our finances. We need to surrender our finances to God. He will always make a way for us. Elder Les Benedum preached from I Samuel 6: 7-14. We get so burdened down with things that the enemy gives us to carry. So often people fail to accept a burden from the Lord, yet are quick to take up burdens not from Him, such as guilt and shame. Don't carry what is not yours to carry. God will not put upon us more than we are able to bear. He'll give us the strength to carry our load. Jesus said, "Take my yoke upon you…For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light" (Mt 11)
