Elder Lorren Godwin preached "In Preparation" from I Peter 5: 8-9. We need to be always ready for an attack from our enemy. Be strong in the Lord. Be alert! The devil knows that if we take our eyes off Jesus, we'll become weak, and then he can attack us. We must be sober; be vigilant; watching always. Jesus told Simon, "Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat" (Luke 22:31). Strengthen your faith. Keep praying constantly. Seek God's face continually.
