#### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught from Acts 2:16-21. Heaven is a place where there are many little children. If children die before their inherited sin-nature results in acts of willful sin, then there is no guilt yet. Jesus said: "Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven" (Mat. 19:14). Joel chapter 2 (cited in Acts 2) is a prophecy mentioning dreams and visions. Every Christian should have a vision or dream that America will one day stop killing preborn babies. A preborn baby is a person. A preborn baby has personal attributes. In Luke 1:41, Elisabeth's baby felt joy and the babe leaped in her womb. In Scripture, preborn babies (including Jesus and others) are referred to by personal pronouns before they were born. "And thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). "Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee" (Jeremiah 1:5). Abortion is killing someone, a person, and therefore wrong.

#### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Hallelujah Praise" from various psalms. Psalms 111-117 are known as a set of Hallelujah Psalms, not to be confused with the Egyptian Hallel, which is comprised of Psalms 113-118 and enclosed in a cluster of psalms (111-119) that are framed by unusual acrostics (alphabetic sequences). These celebrate God's salvation on behalf of his people. Psalms 111 and 112 are twins, written together and meant to be read together. Psalm 111's focus is God, while 112's focus is a godly man. One can see hints of the dual nature of Christ in these twin psalms. We should praise God at all times. Let our glory be to the Lord alone. "I love the Lord, because he hath heard my voice and my supplication" (Psalm116:1). The Word of God lets us know that God is a pro-life God, calling us to be pro-life people. The culture of death around us not only wants to murder preborn persons on a whim, but also advocates assisted suicide and pressures the elderly to seek death if their "quality of life" is less than ideal. We should reject these notions, and see every day "above ground" as another opportunity to praise our God and witness to people about Him! He wants man to call upon His name, accept His salvation, and fulfill our vows to Him. He deserves our highest praise. "Hallelujah" refers to our highest praise.

### Wednesday

Elder Brian Murphy Jr. preached "Called At This Time To Fight" from Ephesians 6:10-20, II Corinthians 5:1 & Mark 4:35-41. We have all been called to fight. We are in a war, not against flesh and blood, but spiritual wickedness in high places. It's time for us to speak boldly God's Truth. It's time to **stand** and let our light shine forth. The devil may tell us to give up, but tell him "No." Even the wind and sea obey our God! Elder Baron Claypool preached "Ever So Much More So" from Hebrews 2:1-3. Every day we must let God's Spirit lead us. We need to stand up and boldly proclaim "Thus saith the Lord". Be careful how we build on God's heritage. We need to be ever so much more on fire for God than the world is for the devil. We need to ever so much more tell the truth of God's Word. We need to ever so much more be faithful to God.


