### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Reaching Up To Abba Father" from II Corinthians 12:7-9 & Galatians 4:1-7. We try within ourselves to be great but our interpretation of greatness is upside down. Greatness is being faithful to God, our heavenly Dad. "Abba" is an Aramaic word for "daddy." We need to have an intimate relationship with God just as a child has with his daddy. Only those who have repented, been baptized in Jesus' name, been filled with the Holy Ghost, are the children of God. "We have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace" (Ephesians 1:7). He treats His children differently than He treats unbelievers. If we fail to live holy, He will chasten us. We can accomplish nothing on our own, but through God we can do all things. We were adopted into His family. He chose us! We have the privilege of calling Him Abba, Father. He longs to hear us call Him Daddy. We are heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ. We can reach out to God as a child reaches out to their daddy, with no fear, but rather knowing that he or she will receive what is asked.

### Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Abundant Life – How to Live in Abundance" from John 10:10. Jesus Christ came that people may have life and have it more abundantly. We cannot live an abundant life without the Holy Ghost living in us day by day. When we receive the Holy Ghost, we receive Jesus. His Word is in us. We were dead in sins and trespasses until God breathed life in us when He gave us the Holy Ghost. We must live a repented life every day. Jesus said, "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15). If we truly love God, we will obey His Word. If He is not Lord of everything in our life, He's not Lord at all. It is not ordained of God for us to have the spirit of fear. The Lord Jesus Christ is the vine and we are the branches. We must abide in Him; in Him is perfect love. God purges us (prunes the branches) so we will bring forth more fruit. If we obey Him, our joy will be full. We must be in Jesus, walking after the Spirit, not after the flesh.

### Wednesday

Elder Charles Hoskins preached "Uncommon Blessings, Unmerited Favor!" from Psalms 23:1-6 & I Kings 17:1-16. In a time of drought and famine, God provided for Elijah by commanding ravens, and later a widow, to feed him. God has all power. He hid Elijah from the enemy. God is our protector, support, security, and advocate. The ravens brought Elijah bread and flesh in the mornings and evenings. He received water from a brook. God is remarkable, extraordinary, unconventional and unusual. He will show up in an unaccustomed circumstance. When the brook dried up (as there was no rain), God told Elijah to go to Zarephath where He had commanded a widow woman to sustain him. Even though she barely had any food for her and her son, she listened to the man of God. Through listening, she and her son were spared from death. The word of the man of God will provide life if you obey. We can have uncommon blessings & unmerited favor!





**A Piece of Pumpkin Pie**



**This Tuesday is Veterans Day!**



**Tuesday, November 11<sup>th</sup> is Veterans Day.** We can never repay the Soldiers, Sailors, Marines, Airmen, and Coast Guardsmen who have risked all to defend our liberty. Yet these brave men and women need our help to defend theirs!

Unknown to most Americans, political appointees in the Obama administration and senior officers inside the military, cooperating with civilian anti-Christian and sexual activist groups, have radically changed military policy, training and culture. In fact some service members are being subjected to training that claims that the “greatest threats facing the country... come from evangelical Christians [and] the tea party.”

Consequently, some in our military have endured hostility simply because they are Bible-believing Christians. They’ve been silenced from sharing their faith, forbidden from praying publicly in the name of Jesus, and dismissed from duty for refusing to approve of same-sex “marriage.”

**Action Steps:**
