Pastor Joseph preached "A Place of Shelter" from Psalm 91:1 & Isaiah 4:2-6. We cannot hide our sins. "For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested" (Mark 4: 22). We can't run from our sins. They will follow us wherever we go. We need a shelter from the consequences of our sins. Where can we find this? Jesus is the answer. Pastor Joseph preached about the Christmas story from I Timothy 3:16. The salvation story of Jesus can be seen from His conception, to the birth in the manger, to the cross, resurrection, ascension, and beyond. Christmas paved the way for His crucifixion, which was the sacrificial atonement for our sins. Christ is formed is us through the indwelling of His Spirit. The Holy Ghost puts the Christmas spirit in us. We should live for Him not just on December 25, but every day of the year. 
