Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught against racism. He used Acts 10:1-37 for his text. Racism that is wrongful discrimination is a sin. Some look down upon, or are partial to, others because of religion, nationality, family, etc. Some may use a characteristic such as if the person wears a police badge or the color of one's skin. All mankind is of one blood. We are not to show partiality. Peter was shown a vision of animals that were ceremonially unclean. He was told to "kill and eat." Peter refused. The Lord taught him, "What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common" (Acts 10: 15). Peter, like many Jews, had carried a racial prejudice against non-Jews, but God showed him that He could save non-Jews. "God is no respecter of persons" (Acts 10:34). All men are created equal. Jesus Himself talked to a Samaritan woman at the well and told her He could give her "living water" (John 4:10). The salvation of Jesus is for everyone regardless of nationality, skin color, or even a sinful past.

Pastor Joseph preached "Buy The Truth and Sell It Not" from Proverbs 23:23. Jesus is the Truth. Every word of the Bible is Truth. Don't follow your heart because it is deceitful and wicked. Follow Truth in the Word of God. We must walk, live, and speak Truth. We were all born in sin. God will transform us from a sin-cursed life to a sin-free life. He leads and guides His people in Truth. We must stay in the Word of God and not back up. Jesus said, "If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8: 31-32). Don't go to a church to see signs and miracles but go because they preach the truth. A love of truth protects against delusion and lies.

Wednesday

Elder Charles Hoskins preached "Weapon Of Our Warfare—Prayer" from Ephesians 6:10-12, 18. There is a universal conflict going on in the earth. The opposing forces are light and darkness. We need to dedicate ourselves and make up our minds that we will not back up on God's word. Prayer is the most powerful of all weapons that God has committed to us.
