Pastor Joseph preached "Rock of Ages Cleft for Me" from Exodus 33:21-23. We must build our house upon the rock, Jesus Christ. If our house is built upon this rock, its foundation will stand sure; it cannot sink. Although God had performed numerous miracles for the Children of Israel, they turned their backs on Him. When Moses had went upon the mountain to pray, the people went to Aaron and asked him to make them idols to worship. They desired to serve other gods instead of the one true God. When we start feeling like we want to be like the world, we need to call upon God to bring us closer to Him and put us in the "cleft of the rock." We must think, act, speak, and dress as God instructs us, yet it is the holy presence of God's Spirit in us that makes us truly holy. We must repent, be baptized in Jesus' name and receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Jesus Christ is our Rock, the rock of refuge, salvation, and strength. We can come to Him and find shelter in the cleft of the rock. If we live a sinful life, we will be in a terrible pit. But if we build our lives upon the rock, Jesus Christ, we can "speak to the rock" and find shelter from the storms of life.

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "I Am Not Going There" from Luke 22:31-32. In the 1958 NFL championship game, Raymond Berry set a record in catching passes. He was an average wide receiver of average speed and skill, but he was a good planner. His secret? He knew the field was in poor shape in certain areas, so he ran to those spots to cause the defender to slip and lose traction, often falling down, enabling him to beat them to the ball. As a result, he caught a record 12 passes that day. The record stood until 55 years later. His knowledge of the field and the pitfalls allowed him to gain advantage over his opponents. Satan knows the areas he can take us to that will allow him to gain an advantage over us. He knows what will cause you to stumble and loose your momentum. He knows how to get you into situations that will cause you to fall, and cause you to be defeated. Don't let him take you there! The devil has one plan, and that is to destroy every Christian. He really doesn't have to get you to sin, if he can distract you. If he can deflect your attention or your focus, he has won. "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour" (1 Peter 5:8).

He is part of a Bridgeport High School student trio that won first place in a WV State Business Competition!


