Pastor Joseph preached "Framed!" from Genesis 37: 23-36. In one sense, to "frame" someone means to make them appear guilty of a sin they didn't commit. Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery and then made their father think that a wild animal had killed him. Joseph was later sold to Potiphar, whose wife desired to commit adultery. When Joseph refused her seduction, she took hold of his coat. She used it to frame him. Joseph could not protect his reputation, but he had protected his character. Reputation is what people think I am; character is what I am. Twice Joseph's coat was used to deceive others, but God had a plan. People may frame you with lies and deceitful circumstantial evidence. Protect your character, trust God, and keep your heart right with God, and He will exalt you. God has a plan for your life! Don't lose hope! In another sense, to "frame" something is to put it inside an open structure that holds it. When something is beautiful and worthy to be displayed, it is often highlighted by being framed. A frame sets it apart from other things. Let us be framed in the beauty and splendor of God's holiness. We are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession. We must "put on Christ" and lay aside our own way of living. Jesus was wrongfully framed with our sins so that we might be framed with His righteousness.





