We need to trust God in times of discouragement and despair. He has never failed! When God makes you a promise, it will come to pass. We must keep going on and serve Him in our darkest hour. We must stand on the promises of God. He has a plan for your life. Things may not happen when you think they should, but you can know of a surety that God will keep His promises. For this reason God knew that the old covenant wasn't viable, so He made a new and better covenant. Jesus was born as God manifest in the flesh. He died on the cross as a sacrifice for our sins. The crucifixion was the plan of God. Yet, He looked beyond that and saw the resurrection. Jesus Christ lives today! His eternal plan is for us to be born again. Jesus told Nicodemus, "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:3). "Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of Heaven" (John 3:5). "Ye must be born again" (John 3:7). We must repent and lay aside our worldly ways of living, be water baptized in Jesus name and receive the Holy Ghost. When you receive the Holy Ghost, there will be a sound: "thou hearest the sound thereof ...so is every one that is born of the Spirit" (John 3:8). On the Day of Pentecost, they spoke with tongues when the Holy Ghost was poured upon them. (Acts 2) This eternal plan extends to you and me. We must be born again!


Wednesday

President Ronald Reagan first issued a presidential proclamation on January 16, 1984, designating Sunday, January 22, 1984 as National Sanctity of Human Life Day, noting that it was the 11th anniversary of Roe v. Wade (and Doe v. Bolton), in which the U.S. Supreme Court issued a ruling that legalized abortion in America without regulation, effectively even up until the time of birth, overturning many laws already on the books that had previously regulated abortion. President Reagan was a strong pro-life advocate who stated that in the infamous decision the high court had "struck down our laws protecting the lives of unborn children." Annually thereafter, Reagan issued the proclamation designating Sanctity of Human Life Day to be the third Sunday in January, which represents the closest Sunday to the original date. His successor, President George H. W. Bush, continued the annual proclamation throughout his presidency. Bush's successor, President Bill Clinton, discontinued the practice throughout his eight years in office, but Bush's son and Clinton's successor, George W. Bush, resumed the proclamation, and did so every year of his presidency. President Barack Obama has never issued any proclamation for the event, and he has proved to be the most proabortion president in our nation's history. However, despite this, the Pro-Life movement has continued to delcare and honor this event even in those years when a presidential proclamation was absent. With taxpayer money & Obamacare's mandated health insurnance taxes going to fund abortions, against the will of many Americans, and in some cases without their knowledge, it has never been more needful for Christians to pray, vote, and get involved in such a moral issue.
