## Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught a Bible lesson titled "Ascending Vapors" from Psalm 135:7. Although the Bible is not intended by God to be a science book, it is never inaccurate in the science facts shown within it. There have been times when mankind's "science" ideas were contrary to the Bible, but after mankind learned more, it was shown that the Bible's message about the given issue was factually correct. For instance, the Bible revealed the spherical nature of the earth thousands of years before mankind got past flat-earth theories. Likewise, man's science long held that the cosmos had no beginning, but eventually cosmology proved the universe did in fact have a beginning, as the Bible declares. Our text is one of three places in scripture that reveal what is now called the hydrologic cycle, shown in scripture thousands of years before man's science caught up. The rain that descends and gives physical life can be compared to the Word of God that descends and gives spiritual life, and the vapor that ascends can be compared to the fulfilled Word of God, and also to the praise and prayers of the saints ascending to the throne of God. Pastor Joseph made other life-applications, such as that we (believers) are like vapors who need to stick together to form spiritual rain. In godly friendship and fellowship, friends shape friends (Proverbs 27:17), love each other (John 15:14-17), and stick together (Hebrews 10:25). When God's Word is finally poured out in judgment against unbelievers, it will result in wrath and punishment, but His Word poured out on believers brings life, healing, and hope. We respond by sending up vapors of praise and worship. When the praises go up, the glory comes down!

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached a powerful message about accountability titled "Prodigy or Prodigal" from the Lord's parable of the prodigal (i.e. wasteful) son, in Luke 15:11-32. The younger son actually did not leave the father's house as a prodigal (wasteful person), but as a prodigy (an exceptionally gifted person). It was only after he left his covering of accountability that he became wasteful. He probably could have written a book titled "How To Become A Prodigal One Step At a Time." Some people only live righteously out of loyalty to a parent or loved one, only to backslide when that person dies or is no longer connected to them. Yet we owe a higher debt of accountability and stewardship directly to the Lord God, not just to a human person we don't want to disappoint. We all need accountability. It is our choice to be accountable — or not. Will you be a prodigy or a prodigal?

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "I Want To See Jesus" from Luke 19:1-5. More than anything else in the world we should want to see Jesus. He is our Saviour, our Healer, our Redeemer. 




