## Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Joy In The Morning" from Psalm 30:5. "For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning" (Psalms 30:5). The key to victory is to not get bogged down in the day-to-day burden, but to keep an attitude of praise. Even when things aren't going well and it seems like God isn't there for us, He has promised to never leave us nor forsake us. He promises to inhabit the praises of His people. The best way to change your situation is to create an environment of praise! Whenever you feel discouraged, or think the situation is hopeless, begin to praise Him and watch Him work!

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Missed in the Market" from John 5 (the account of a lame man healed by Jesus at the Pool of Bethesda, where a sheep market was) and Matthew 20 (Jesus' parable about a householder who kept going back to the market to hire more helpers to bring in his harvest). In both passages a similar excuse was offered; the lame man said "I have no man..." (to help me into the water), and those hired at the eleventh hour said "No man hath hired us..." God's greatest blessings to mankind have been accomplished by God utilizing a **human**. Think of Abraham and Moses. Ultimately, think of the Lord Jesus Christ. Consider that we, as ambassadors for Christ, have been given the modern-day duty of His ministry of reconciliation! At Judgment Day, may no one who is lost from this local area say, "I had no man to tell me the Gospel..." Let's strive to make sure that no one is **missed in the market** of life! You are the human being that God wants to use to help someone!

## Wednesday

Elder Zach Sandy preached "The Earthquake of Clarksburg" from Acts 16:16-30. When Paul and Silas were beaten and cast into jail with their feet in stocks because they taught about Jesus, they prayed and sang praises unto God. Suddenly there was an earthquake and the doors were open and they were loosed. We need to walk by faith, not by sight. 




