Pastor Joseph preached "The Sermon on the Mount" from Matthew 5. The sermon on the mount consists of possible standards/standards that you can live up to. The beatitudes explain to us that we are to be set apart from this world. Then we are blessed people who God is pleased with. We are to be the salt and the light of the world. Salt flavors and stops corruption. We are to let our light shine so everyone can see Christ in us. Jesus didn't come to destroy the law, but to fulfil the law. The Old Testament says "Thou shalt not kill", but our wrong attitudes and words count the same as murder. The Old Testament says "Thou shalt not commit adultery", but lustful imaginations are the same as adultery. We are to go farther than the old teachings were. We are to love our neighbors and our enemies. We should live to be pleasing to God, not to men. We are to live our lives in a perfect manner.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Margin of Error" from Hebrews 9:22 and Matthew 26:39. The Lord Jesus was obedient even unto the death of the cross, accomplishing a monumental task in which He had zero margin of error. If He had shied away and avoided the utter and complete suffering, humiliation, and death by crucifixion, He would have forfeited the salvation for all mankind that His obedience (to the eternal plan of God) obtained. Because He had zero margin of error, he bought for us a tremendous margin, the freedom to repent and have our sins (deadly errors) washed by the blood. We have a margin for our errors that is marked in red - blood red. Yet still our margin is not without limits: unrepentant sins are not covered, and blasphemy against the Holy Ghost is not covered even if one would try to repent of it. Of particular note is the stern warning from the Lord against those that would harm the little ones (obviously referring to child abuse, but also by application referring to those that offend new converts). In Mark 9:42 and Luke 17:2 He said in their judgment it would be better if they had suffered a mill stone being tied around their neck and being thrown into the sea. Don't be guilty of blocking someone's path into the Kingdom of God by harsh words or mean treatment! We MUST be about our Father's business, speaking the truth in love in this wayward culture, and being the salt and light that our Lord's expects us to be. The cost of our error in that could affect someone for eternity.

Elder Chuck Hoskins preached about God's grace from Psalm 23:1-6, 91:1-16. God's grace abounds wherever His people walk, provided He is our Shepherd and we are walking after Him. He is our leader! His grace brings us peace. By His grace, the moving of God's Spirit can lift all of the burdens we carry and relieve the tensions we have! The Scriptures promise to us that, "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty." God is our refuge. He is our fortress. He is worthy of all our trust in Him. None of us deserve miracles and healings. Sin, sickness, and death are the general rule for all of mankind, but by God's grace He will make exceptions to the rule for us.
