Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Touching Him" from Mark 5:24-29. Are you seeking to touch Jesus or are you waiting for Him to touch you? Too many people are concerned about their own needs. We must put God first, and then us. We pray for people, but are we *really* praying or satisfying ourselves, so we can say we prayed for them? This is why people go through life not getting what they need from God. We need to open the gates of Heaven when we pray. We need to seek the face of God. We need to fix or focus our mind's attention and our heart's affection on Him. We need to talk to Him like we would our dad. Have a relationship with Jesus. Know Him! The woman with an issue of blood was determined to see Jesus. She let nothing stop her from touching Jesus. We must sacrifice our wants and be willing to pay the price to be a vessel God can use.

Pastor Joseph preached "Freedom" from II Chronicles 20:20-22 & Isaiah 10:27. When Jehoshaphat recognized that the battle wasn't his and he needed help from God, his army won the battle. When we are shackled with battles, we need the anointing and strength of God to rise above them. "My strength is made perfect in weakness" (II Corinthians 12:9). God knows our problems. When we realize that we can do nothing on our own, He comes to our rescue. He is the Great Physician, the Almighty God. Jesus is I Am. He's our healer, our provider, our salvation – whatever we need. He can get people out of situations that no one else can. Lazarus was bound hand and foot, but he found a way to get to Jesus. We must focus with our whole mind and soul and find a way to get to Him. Never go back to the tomb after you've been to the King's table. Choose life over sin and death.


